Started in a high school lunch line decades ago by 3 seniors that soon added another member and began playing gigs almost immediately, Grandview Station kept a busy playing schedule for the next few years, mostly playing club circuits in south Arkansas. As the years progressed the band eventually dissolved and some members continued to perform with other groups and musicians.

One particular member continued playing club circuits with cover bands for the next 2 decades. At the same time he worked at writing original material with the hopes of someday getting a break with it and getting something picked up. "I always wrote songs but the gigs I played were primarily cover gigs so we didn't perform very many originals live" says Scott Arivett, lead singer and guitarist for Grandview Station and other subsequent groups.

After eventually having some success getting songs picked up and recorded by a major label act, Arivett decided to embark on an album project that would feature his compositions done in a pro studio with the help of some of the best musicians he'd encountered over the years. After much deliberation he decided to resurrect the original band name for the project. "I tried several things before that and none of them really felt right until I decided to go back to my roots with Grandview Station. It was the first band name I ever came up with and used, and after 30+ years of playing it is probably going to be my last."
