4. Photograph and location details of the Discovery Monument

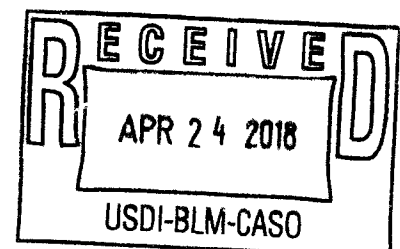

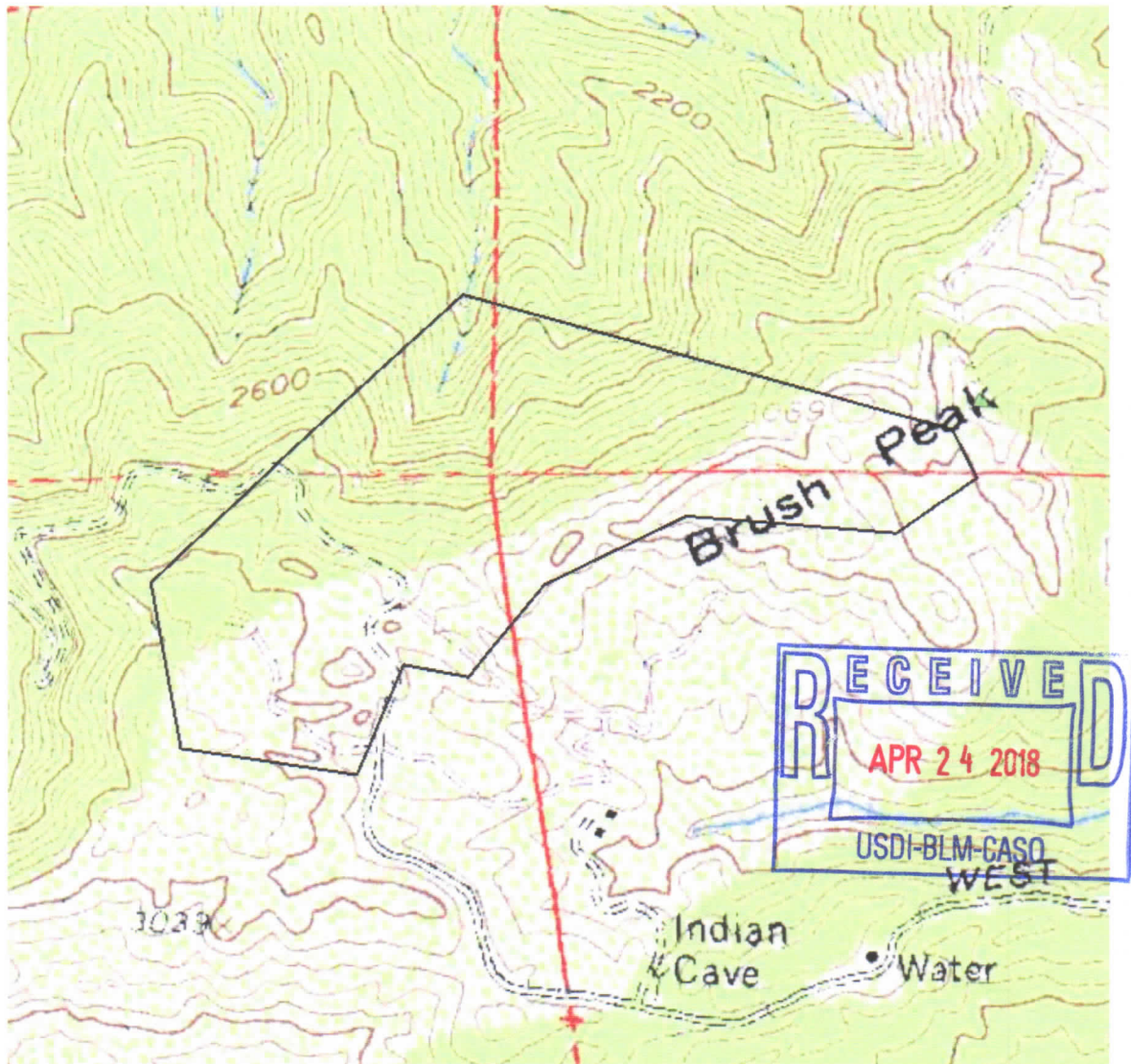
