## Sunday's Sermon

"Ways to an Expected End"

**Key Verse:** *"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end."* **Jeremiah 29:11 (KJV)**

## Breakdown of Jeremiah 29

- I. Jeremiah's EXHORTATION to the Jews (Jeremiah 29:1-9).
- II. Jeremiah's ENUNCIATION to the Jews (Jeremiah 29:10-32).

## WAYS TO AN EXPECTED END

- I. Your path to an expected end must avoid DECEPTION.
  - a. **Jeremiah 29:8-9 (NKJV)** – <sup>8</sup>... *Do not let your prophets and your diviners ... deceive you, ...* <sup>9</sup>...*they prophesy falsely to you in My name;*
- II. Your path to an expected end must endure TRANSPIRATION.
  - a. **Jeremiah 29:10 (NKJV)** – "...: *After seventy years are completed at Babylon, I will visit you ...*"
- III. Your path to an expected end must include SUPPLICATION.
  - a. **Jeremiah 29:12 (NKJV)** - *Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you.*
- IV. Your path to an expected end must comprise EXPLORATION.
  - a. **Jeremiah 29:13 (NKJV)** - *And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.*
- V. Your path to an expected end must embrace EXPECTATION.
  - a. **Jeremiah 29:14 (NKJV)** - *I will be found by you, says the Lord, and I will bring you back from your captivity; I will gather ....*"*you from all the nations*
