

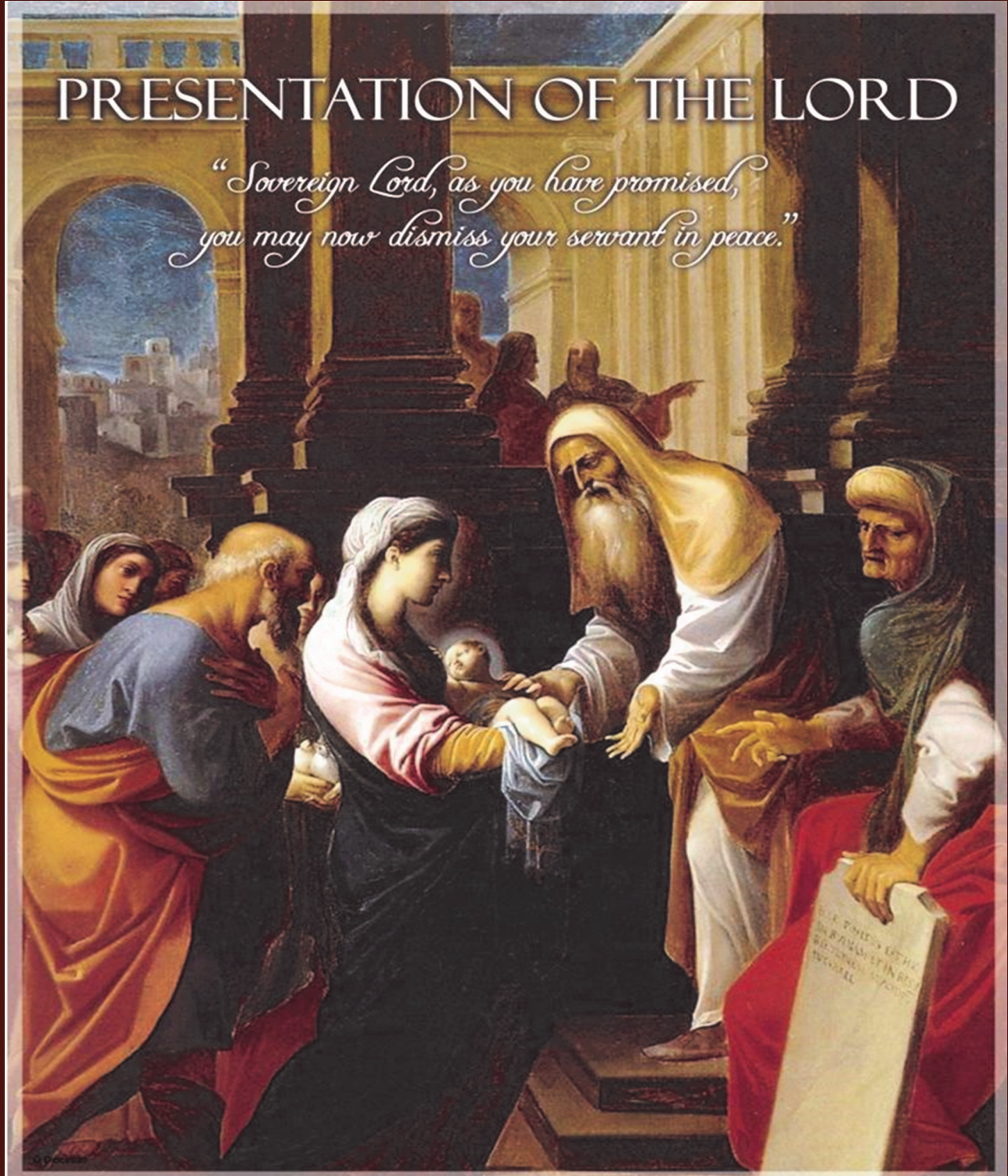

Catholic Ministry Appeal Second Collection This Weekend



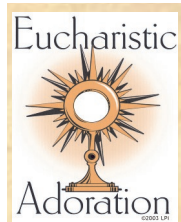
The Catholic Ministries Appeal is the annual campaign to support six local ministries that teach, feed, and heal.
