National Forester's Report Dr. Mark J. Kimsey, Jr.

The 2018-2019 academic year inducted 370 students into Xi Sigma Pi. There were 342 inducted unique to the academic year, with an additional 28 revised into past academic years. The unique AY inductions are above the 5-yr running average of 318, so kudos to all the chapter advisors and officers, your efforts are greatly appreciated.

We would like to recognize Dr. Roger Williams at the The Ohio State University for taking the lead to bring a chapter of Xi Sigma Pi to their campus. Starting academic year of 2019-2020, Xi Sigma Pi will inaugurate the Alpha Psi chapter at OSU – the 45^{th} chapter of our historic honor society. In addition to the newest chapter, several Universities are working to reinstate an active chapter. There continue to be a number of inactive chapters; however, the National Office will continue to work with interested faculty to help facilitate their reinstatement.

Scholarships were awarded to five exceptional students during the 2018-2019 academic year. Additional information on these awardees and on the chapter advisors who served as reviewers is provided later in this newsletter. I want to express my appreciation to those advisors who gave their time to help evaluate scholarship applications.

Our web presence (www.XiSigmaPi.org) has improved through partnering with Ionos 1-1 web domain hosting. A Google search now lists our Wikipedia and official website as the first two search items, a considerable improvement over past years. Your comments and suggestions on ways to improve the website can be sent to our email address: NationalOffice@XiSigmaPi.org. Also, please send captioned pictures of your chapter's XSP activities. We would like to post them in our picture gallery.

In 2017-2018 we partnered with ZoHo, an online bookkeeping software to track expenses, send invoices and receive online payments for 2018-2019. The bookkeeping aspect of this partnership did not meet our needs and that partnership will be discontinued. The primary reason for this breakdown is due to half our business still conducted through mail. Moving into the future, the national office will refine its Excel bookkeeping accounts to meet IRS requirements, while partnering with Paypal to receive online payments. The advantages will be no annual bookkeeping fee to ZoHo and the same pricing for processing payments.

The National Office continues to reside at the University of Idaho for the 2019-2020 academic year. Discussions for succession will begin fall 2019 with prospective chapters to assume national leadership for academic year 2020-2021.

Work items for 2019-2020 are 1) continue pursuing IRS 501c(3) non-profit status, 2) build out a macro based Excel bookkeeping software solution, 3) set up a Paypal business account, 4) endeavor to reinstate more chapters, and 5) add pre-2006 inductees to Dr. Ficklin's comprehensive registry.

The next annual business meeting will be held at the Society of American Foresters convention in Louisville, KY on October 31st, 4-5PM in Boardroom A within the Kentucky International Convention Center.

This suspension would allow us flexibility to accomplish several strategic goals: reinstatement with ACHS, resolve IRS tax-exempt status, and build a national website. The first and last of those strategic goals are complete. Once the IRS tax exempt process is complete we will re-evaluate XSP fund balance to determine if a second scholarship is financially viable.

Xi Sigma Pi Executive Council Meeting Minutes (SAF Convention, October 4, 2018)

Meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm.

Attendees: Mark Kimsey, Tony D'Amato, Denver Hospodarsky, John Zobel, Matthew McBroom, Arianna McGlynn (Humboldt Chapter President), Joe Conrad, Kelly McCarter, Nilesh Timilsina, Fernando Resende, Miranda Curzon, Darcy Hammond (Idaho Chapter President)

After introductions, the meeting began with new business because of the need for several attendees to depart early for other meetings.

New business

- a. IRS 501c3 designation
 - We discussed the need to incorporate as a 501c3. Our current status makes it difficult to maintain banking relationships. In addition, our lack of documentation with the IRS could become a problem. Our current status may also be a recruiting barrier given the number of disreputable honor societies in existence today.
 - If we pursue incorporation in Idaho as a 501c3, we will need to amend the existing constitution/by-laws to replace executive council with a board of directors consisting of 3-5 members and a president, vice president, and treasurer.
 - The Association of College Honor Societies (ACHS) requires student election of representatives, meaning we would have to change how the national leadership is selected. A student-elected position could be added if/when constitution/by-laws are updated for 501c3 designation.
 - ACHS provided several examples of constitutions/by-laws.
 - An attendee suggested that the board of directors should serve staggered 2 or 3 year terms to maintain continuity as members cycle on and off the board. The board of directors could function similarly to the current scholarship review committee.
 - Mark Kimsey will circulate a track changes file with the changes to the constitution/by-laws needed to incorporate as a 501c3. A conference call will be scheduled after Christmas break.

Old business

- a. Scholarship awards was discussed. There were no applicants from the western region. There were no second-place scholarships because of budgetary constraints.
- b. Status of chapters was discussed. Several previously inactive chapters are now active. A number of chapters remain inactive, however.
- c. Website development was discussed. A student at the University of Idaho developed the website. Individual chapters should consider linking their Facebook pages to the national site. Chapters should also send pictures for posting on the website. Some chapters may want to elect a social media officer to promote the

- society. Local chapters should link to the national site to increase the status of the national site within Google. <u>Please remove the initiation document from the website because some chapters may have closed initiations.</u>
- d. National office will remain at the University of Idaho while the incorporation issue is being resolved.

Treasurer's report

- The treasurer's report was presented by Mark Kimsey. The finances are in good order. We are banking with Wells Fargo and have a better CD rate than with the previous bank.

New Business

- a. Scholarships for 2018-2019 were discussed. Seek applications for 2019.
- b. Stole vendor change. We have switch to Balfour because of a long delay from the previous vendor. We were already working with Balfour for other business, and so the change has streamlined operations.
- c. National dues rate will remain the same.

The meeting adjourned at 4:05 pm.

Administrative Guidelines for New Officers and Chapter Advisors SUMMARY OF ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

ORDERING MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATES AND RECORD KEEPING

IMPORTANT READING FOR CHAPTER ADVISORS AND OFFICERS

Conducting initiations, ordering membership certificates and graduation stoles for new initiates and reporting annual activities to the National Office are important, but relatively easy actions, expected of an active Xi Sigma Pi Chapter.

If a new Chapter Advisor has been appointed, the previous Advisor should brief him or her. The new Advisor should also get the Xi Sigma Pi Administrative Handbook. The name, mailing address and email address of the new advisor should also be sent to the Xi Sigma Pi National Office.

To ensure an orderly transition each academic year, **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED** that the newly elected and out-going officers meet with the Chapter Advisor to review procedures and expectations.

PROCEDURES

Chapter Officers should familiarize themselves with these procedures, as well as with the Constitution and By-laws of the Society of Xi Sigma Pi and the local chapter. It is the responsibility of retiring officers to familiarize their successors with chapter records and procedures. Chapter officers are urged to work closely with the faculty Advisor (Executive Council Representative) in following these procedures.

I. INITIATION:

It is the responsibility of the chapter to determine that all persons nominated for membership meet the criteria set forth in Article III of the Constitution.

A major responsibility of chapter officers is to assure that membership certificates are presented to new initiates as soon as possible after each initiation. To this end, the procedures in this statement should be followed promptly and with care.

- **A.** Timing of initiation: In so far as possible, initiation should be scheduled before March 1. Approximately 6-8 weeks are required for processing and delivery of membership certificate orders. Submit the initiation certificate order and payment to the National Office for processing.
- B. Immediately after each initiation, send the certificate order form (Balfour Excel spreadsheet) and a check payable to "Xi Sigma Pi National Office" to the National Office. Lifetime national dues, including membership certificate, are \$15.00 per initiate.

C. Ordering membership certificates: the National Office now prepares the certificate order via an Excel spreadsheet of new initiates submitted by local chapters. Therefore, it is extremely important that the information in the file be accurate. Chapters should submit the file electronically by attaching it to an email addressed to the National Forester.

Please also mail a hard copy print-out of the file along with the dues check to the National Office, and always keep a hard copy of the certificate orders for chapter records.

D. If a membership certificate contains an error:

- a) If the error is made by the initiating chapter (e. g. name misspelled or wrong date), the chapter is responsible for paying to have a new certificate issued. Replacement certificates cost \$5.00 plus shipping and they can be included along with regular orders for new initiates. Simply include a note in the Excel spreadsheet explaining which certificate(s) is a replacement.
- b) If the error is made by the National Office or the Balfour Company, the certificate will be reprinted at no cost to the local chapter.
- **E.** Ordering graduation stoles: the National Office has stoles available for purchase. Cost is \$35/stole + shipping. Request can be conducted by email; however, please also mail a hard copy request along with the amount due to the National Office. Always keep a hard copy of the request for chapter records.
- **F.** Ordering society pins: the National Office can now order society pins. Minimum order size is 100 at a chapter cost of \$12.00/pin + shipping. Request can be conducted by email. Always keep a hard copy of the request for chapter records. If a minimum order of 100 is not reached (inclusive of all chapter requests), funds will be refunded to the chapter.



II. CHAPTER ACTIVITIES:

The Chapter Activities is an annual report of activities for the academic year. The activities should be filled out by each chapter at their last meeting of the academic year and forwarded to the National Office for the annual report. Chapters **must submit the file electronically** by attaching it to an email addressed to the National Office. The call for activity reports will be made in the spring, but submissions may be sent electronically at any time.
