

# Solanco Youth Basketball Code of Conduct

The purpose of the Solanco Youth Basketball Program (SYBP) is to encourage participation and the pursuit of excellence in all aspects of the game of basketball.

Solanco Youth Basketball (SYB) offers to its participants the commitment to this mission.

The privilege of participation may, therefore, be withdrawn or denied by SYB at any time where SYB determines that a participant or participant's parents, or legal guardian's conduct is inconsistent with the mission of the Solanco Youth Basketball Program.

The following code of conduct is required of all SYB participants, parents or legal guardians at SYB games and practices.

## **All participants of SYB, whether parents, legal guardians, or player participants, shall:**

- Continue to protect and improve the excellent reputation of the SYB.
- Behave in such a way that his/her actions reflect positively on SYB.
- Respect the efforts of coaches and volunteers, at practices and games.
- Not use profanity or generally abusive language at any time during practices or games.
- Respect and obey the building/facility rules of the Solanco School District while attending practices and games at Solanco School District facilities.
- Be responsible for the conduct of guests or other family members who attend practices or games.

If an incident occurs, which is considered a violation of the SYB Code of Conduct the following steps will occur:

The SYB Board of Directors will be notified of the violation. \*

The SYB participant's coach will speak with the individual regarding the violation. \*

This will be considered a first warning. \*

If a second violation occurs the participant's coach will notify the Solanco Youth Basketball Board of Directors of the violation. The Board of Directors will be responsible for contacting the participant, parent or legal guardian regarding the violation and possible consequence for the violation. Action by the board will include but is not limited to:

1. Second warning. \*
2. Suspension from practices and/or games. \*
3. Formal dismissal from the Solanco Youth Basketball Program. \*  
If a formal dismissal is required for a Code of Conduct violation, program fees will not be refunded. \*

\* If any incident occurs that is deemed a serious violation of conduct the SYB board has the absolute right to dismiss any player or coach immediately without the process mentioned above.
