Data protection declaration

The Young Virtuoso competition takes seriously the protection of the personal data of its participants and its partners; through technical and organisational measures, he has ensured that the legal regulations on data protection are observed and complied with by both him and external service providers. Compliance with this obligation is regularly monitored by the Orga team. The collection, processing, use and transfer of data takes place on the one hand with the consent of the data holder, on the other hand exclusively for the purpose of fulfilling the obligations of the competition. The transfer to third parties is only for compelling reasons and in the interest of competition. The participant concerned has the opportunity at any time to inform himself about the use and whereabouts of his/her protected data; he is entitled to documentation of compliance with data protection regulations in relation to him. He has the right to revoke consent given at any time and to demand the deletion of his data, Art. 17 GDPR.

Competition partners and third parties are protected in the same way by the competition controllers by complying with data protection regulations. There will be no sale or free transfer of data of third parties or partners of the Competition, unless consent has been given to that end.

When external service providers, to whom personal data must be made available, the conclusion of a corresponding contract ensures that the data protection provisions are equally be adhered to.

In the event of revocation or display of incorrectly collected data, these will be deleted immediately, Art. 21, 18 GDPR. The right of complaint to a data protection supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR in accordance with Section 19 of the German Data Protection Act (BDSG) is expressly referred to. The State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information Baden-Württemberg, Königstraße 10a, 70173 Stuttgart, is responsible for us.
