**NALGO Wanderers** joined the League as Old Town Wanderers in 2010, finished their first season in sixth place, but improved to runners-up spot last season. At the time of writing, they lie in fourth position, but with games in hand to third place. They were beaten finalists in this competition last season. They have also reached the final of the Wiltshire FA County Cup.

**Wootton Bassett Town Dev** are in their first season with this League and have been close to the top of Division 1 all season. At the time of writing, they lie in third place, which is creditable achievement for such a young side. In the quarter-finals, they inflicted the first defeat of the season on Madames FC, the Division 1 winners.

The two League games between today's finalists both resulted in wins for Wootton Bassett.

Today's Referee is **David King**, a Level 5 Referee from Swindon. He will be assisted by **Graeme Little** and **Nicholas Stanley**, both from Swindon. **Patrick Butler**, also from Swindon is the Fourth Official.

**Wilts Calne Town FC and Purton FC Res will contest today's Corsham Print Senior KO Cup Final, which kicks off at 5:00pm**

In various guises, **Wilts Calne Town FC** are in their fifth Senior KO Cup Final, having won the very first competition in 1981, then again in 1986 and 2008 and were beaten finalists in 1985. At the time of writing, they've just clinched the Premier Division title.

Despite their long association with the League, **Purton FC** are surprisingly in their first Senior KO Cup Final. At the time of writing, they've just suffered lie in second place in the Premier Division, needing one win from their final two games to clinch runners-up position.

The two League games between today's finalists resulted in a home win for each Club.

The Club hereby grants admission to the ground on condition that spectators will comply with the following rules:

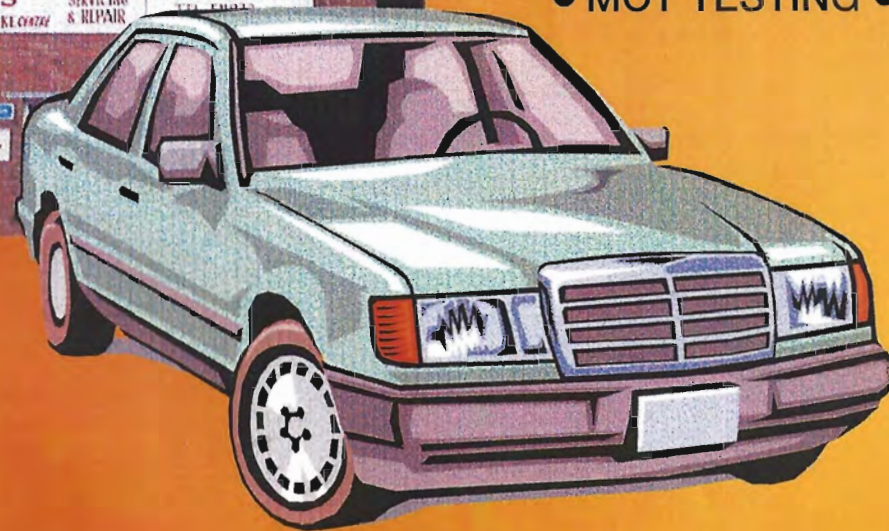
1. Not to trespass onto the playing area
