PURTON FOOTBALL CLUB

Purton Football Club began in 1924 and ran until 1968 when it was disbanded for a few seasons but then re-formed and over the years has won many honours at Senior, Junior and also at Youth Levels

Besides winning league titles the club have won the Wilts Senior Cup 7 times and the Wiltshire Youth Cup 3 times, Fairford Hospital Cup and the Arthur Shipway Cup both three times.

After winning the Wilts County league in 1985/6 the club joined the Hellenic League until the end of the 2016/17 but sadly have had to revert back to the Wilts league as unable to reach ground grading rulings by the FA. By not have flood-lighting and a spectator stand at the their Red House ground .

During their time in the Hellenic League the club secured two league titles in 1995/6 and again in 2003/4 winning the title having not lost a league game all season. The club also won the Supplementary Cup in 2001/2 and runners up in the same cup in 2010/11.

Alan Eastwood is the clubs President, Hon Sec, Press & Programmes and Terry Crumbie the new club Chairman & Hon Treasurer while Andrew Cowan is the clubs Youth/Dev Officer and Vice Chairman.

Neil Lee and Liam Lewis have taken over as joint managers this season after Justin Miller stepped down from the role.

The club's raises funds for sponsors to their club programme with programme adverts, donations match-day sponsorships, £1 point sponsorships, Football card sales and running Race Nights and Sporting Dinners during the season.

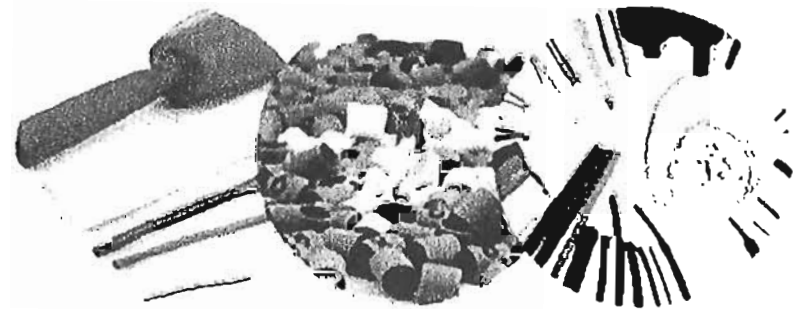
Just kidding?

The Carling Premiership

Facts



On September 5, 1992 Tottenham's Andy Turner became the youngest player to score a Carling Premiership goal when he scored against Everton.

The 1993-94 Carling Premiership season saw the introduction of squad numbers for players.

When the Carling Premiership was founded in 1992, it was formed of 22 clubs. This was reduced to 20 clubs for the 1995-96 season.

Newcastle United set a record in 1993-94 which Nottingham Forest equalled in 1994-95 for the highest placing in their first Carling Premiership season since winning promotion. Both finished third.

Nottingham Forest v Liverpool was the first Carling Premiership match to be shown live on TV, on Sky Sports. Forest won 1-0.

Bryan Robson's first Carling Premiership match for Manchester United was against Middlesbrough, the club he left United to become player-manager in May 1994.

Carling became the sponsors of the Carling Premiership when they signed the deal in February 1993.

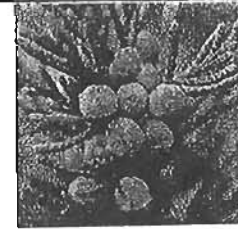
PURTON.....0.....CRICKLADE TOWN.....0

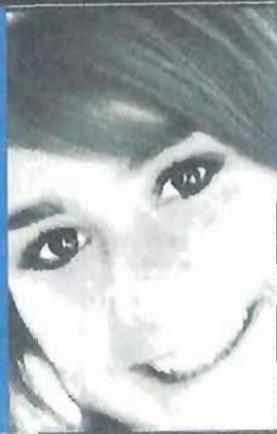

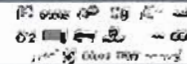
