Club History

Purton Football Club began in 1924 and was run until 1968, when it sadly disbanded. It re-formed and over the years has won many honours at senior, junior and youth levels.

As well as winning the Wilts Senior Cup seven times, and been runners up twice, they have also won the Arthur Shipway Cup and the Fairford Hospital Cup three times, each in recent years. The Club has also won the Wilts Youth Cup three times.

Promoted to the Hellenic League in 1985/6, the Club were sadly demoted back to the Wilts Senior League at the end of the 2016/17 season as it couldn't obtain the ground gradings required by the Football Association.

During the Club's time in the Hellenic League, it secured two winning seasons in 1995/96 and 2003/4, winning the latter without losing a league match under manager Alan Clark.

The Club also won the Hellenic League Sup Cup in 2001/2 and were runners up in the same cup in 2010/11.

The Club is currently run by three people; Alan Eastwood, Club President, Honorary Secretary, Press and Programmes, Terry Crumby, Club Chairman and Honorary Treasurer, and Andy Cowan, Vice Chairman and Youth Development Club officer.

Neil Lee and Liam Lewis, in their second season in charge saw their side into 5th place, a place higher than the previous season and were joined by coach/first aider Paul Farrell in the Wiltshire Senior League (Premier Division). This season Liam Lewis assisted by Paul Farrell will be in charge as Neil Lee has moved on.

The club has a first class main sponsor, thanks to First City Homecare, Mr Keith Trowbridge, who also runs Ashgrove House, a well-known care home in Purton, that has supported the club for many years and for which the club is most indebted.

The Club provides a match-day programme at a cost of £3 and raises funds through match-day sponsorship, donations and programme advertising. It also runs a Pound a Point scheme, football pontoon, Race Nights and sporting dinners.

With the new 2019-20 Season almost upon us, we look forward to the new season with a brief look at each of the teams in the Premier Division for Season 2019-20. The preview is based on pre-season discussions with the respective team managers as they look forward to the coming season.

2018-19 Season Position

After a shaky start last season which saw Purton lose four of their first five games they improved over the season and ended on a massive high with four straight wins, including a 5-1 win over runners-up and cup winners Kintbury Rangers. Indeed, after the turn of the year Purton lost just two games against Corsham Town Res and Wroughton, winning nine and drawing four as they climbed the table to finish in 5th place position, a one place improvement on the previous season.

Who does Liam expect to be the title challengers?

Liam expects the same top three from last season, Wroughton, Kintbury Rangers and Shrewton United to be the main three challengers to his Purton side this coming season.

Which game is Liam most looking forward to?

The game Liam is most looking forward to is the trip to Melksham to play at their superb facilities. He is also excited about playing the three new sides, Frome Collegians, Holt and Stratton Juniors.

Bogey side

Purton's record since they returned to the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League is pretty reasonable against all the 12 sides they have previously played, perhaps one of the three new teams will take on that mantle of their bogey side this coming season.

Pre-season

Pre-season has seen Purton test themselves against higher league opposition, starting with a 5-2 defeat against Step 5 side Shrivenham who play in the Hellenic

Premier Division. They have then gone on to play three Step 6 sides, defeating Pewsey Vale from the Wessex league 2-1, drawing with Cirencester Town Dev from the Hellenic League Division One West, but losing 5-1 to Malmesbury Victoria from the same division. In addition, they have lost to Hellenic Division 2 side Highworth Town Res 2-1 and beaten Swindon & District league side Nalgo Sports 4-3.

Club history: top scorers

In an era when loyalty to one club is often hard to find it is refreshing to report that Alan Eastwood is now in his 47th season at Purton Football Club. Alan joined as a player back in 1972 and has had just about every role in the club since and is now the recognised face of Purton Football Club to everyone in Wiltshire and beyond.

Alan's match day programmes for Purton are renowned for the impressive historical information and it was true to form that a request for some missing goal scorer information resulted in all the goal scorers going back to 1972-73 being provided within a few hours. This enabled the Purton "all-time" record to be fully completed for the period of the existence of the Wiltshire Senior League.

With the Wiltshire County League (the original name of the Wiltshire Senior League) coming into existence in 1976-77 following the amalgamation of the Wiltshire Combination and Wiltshire League, our list omits the goal scorers from those early years of Alan's tenure at Purton but having been provided with the information and seeing that it included Alan himself it is only right that that information is featured here.

Back in the 1970s the Purton goal machine was a certain Allan Coole who finished top scorer seven out of eight of those first years of Alan's time at Purton. Unfortunately, due to a serious illness Coole missed the 1974-75 season and Alan was himself top scorer that season with 24 goals. In those seven seasons when Coole topped the Purton goal scoring chart he bagged an impressive 191 goals (this total also excludes certain supplemental cup competitions).

Coole continued to score Purton's goals in the early years of the new Wiltshire County League. He was finally knocked off top spot by a young striker called Mark Collier who would go on to be the top scorer during Alan's 45 seasons at Purton. Coole did, however, regain the Purton Golden Boot in 1982-83 but Collier eventually went on to be Purton top scorer for 10 of Alan's 45 years at the club. Collier's goals came during a period which saw Purton secure promotion to the Hellenic League and no doubt looks back fondly to his playing days at the Red House.

The record for those early years before the formation of our league were:

1972 - 73	Allan Coole 29
1973 - 74	Allan Coole 32
1974 - 75	Alan Eastwood 24
1975 - 76	Allan Coole 33

Alan Eastwood provided has the all-time top scorers in all competitions over his 47 season period at the club. This includes not only games in the leagues and league and FA knockout competitions that Purton First Team, Reserve Team and Third team played, but also games in the Fairford Hospital Cup and Arthur Shipway Cup competitions.

The top 10 who have all scored over 100 goals for the club reads as follows:

Manager's notes from the dugout

Liam Lewis remains in charge as Purton look forward to their third season back in the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League. However, he will have a new name in the dugout with him as former joint manager Neil Lee has departed and taken over at Pewsey Vale Dev. Liam's assistant for the coming season will be Paul Farrell who was part of the coaching team and proved himself a massive asset to the club hence his appointment as assistant manager for the coming season.



Liam expects his side to be up there challenging for honours this coming season. He has retained the core of last season's side and strengthened in several positions. He feels that on their day his side can beat anyone, evidenced by the wins last season against both of the top two, but his side need to be more consistent this coming season if they are to challenge for league honours.

Liam has made a couple of key signings in attack, whilst retaining the services of last season's top goal scorer Will Backhouse, despite last season's 24 goal man being courted by a number of sides in the area during the summer months. Rob Lincoln returns to Purton after a season playing in the Hellenic Premier for Royal Wootton Bassett Town where he made 32 appearances last season scoring three times. Also joining Purton is former Cricklade Town striker Tom McCulloch, who spent the back end of last season playing for Chippenham Park in the Western League. With the added strikers to the roster, George Drewitt will move back into midfield where he has been Purton's best player in pre-season. Liam has also added a couple of midfield players in youngster Joe English, who is dual signed with Hellenic Premier side Shrivenham, and Liam Griffin who joins from last season's champions Wroughton.

New signing Rob Lincoln, who joins from Hellenic League side Royal Wootton Bassett Town and George Drewitt, who will drop back after playing up front last season and who has shown up well in pre-season.

Purton and Kintbury Rangers brought the 2018-19 Season in the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League Premier Division to a close on a Thursday night at the Red House. Having played Wroughton on the Tuesday night, and with this final game having no consequences for the final league table, Kintbury gave the opportunity to a number of their reserve team players to make the step up to the County League. Purton meanwhile went into the game as one of the form sides in the second half of the season having lost just once in their last twelve games. The home side took an early lead when defender turned striker George Drewitt got on the end of a cross from the right to fire Purton in front with just three minutes on the clock. The lead was doubled shortly afterwards when Daren Regis got behind the Kintbury defence, rounded keeper Kyle Clough and rolled the ball into the net to make it 2-0 to Purton. They increased the lead further on 20 minutes when Nathan Marland beat keeper Clough with a low drive to make it 3-0 and it remained that way at the break.

Kintbury Rangers came out for the second half in more determined fashion. Last seasons top scorer Charlie Allsop, who had only played in ten games this season ahead of the Purton game, went close for Kintbury, but he fired the chance that came his way over the Purton bar. His strike partner on the night, George Smith, has been in good form of late with six goals in the previous four games and it was he who got Kintbury back into the game on the hour mark when the pacey striker beat the offside trap to round the keeper Clough to make it 3-1. Purton responded by creating a couple of chances of their own to restore the three-goal advantage but twice Kyle Clough saved to deny them. Kintbury then went close again themselves when a shot from just outside the box hit the woodwork and bounced to safety. However, Purton made sure of all three points with ten minutes to go when substitute Manuel Mesas fired into the corner of the net to make it 4-1. This was not the end of the scoring on the night as substitute Chris Avery scored his 9th goal of the campaign to make it 5-1 to Purton on the night, as the home side finished the season with four straight wins. If they can keep the same squad of players for next season they are certainly likely to be up their challenging for honours based on their form in the latter half of the season. The goal from George Smith for Kintbury meant that he finished as the second highest scorer in league games on 23, one less than teammate Shaun Thorp who scored 24, although his total would have been three higher had Westbury not withdrawn from the league.
