In fact, Bergman's, Rule of nature states. "larger animals have a lower surface area to volume ratio than smaller animals, so they radiate less body heat per unit of mass, and therefore stay warmer in cold climates. Warmer climates impose the opposite problem: body heat generated by metabolism needs to be dissipated quickly rather than stored within."

We notice it in the **moose hunts**, the biggest moose and thereby the highest priced moose hunts are in Alaska and the Yukon. **The same is true when we speak about whitetail deer everyone knows the biggest ones come out of Canada, but do you know which province or state has the most trophy whitetail deer in the record book, it is Alberta.**

Bears size is a product of his genes and age along with food supply. For a black bear to get big it can be 10-20 years old and must survive that many years to get so big. Being farther north is also a factor of the end product.

Alberta Timber Wolves are the largest of the wolf species, sometimes up to 200 pounds, this is truly the land of the giants. Hunting them over bait makes hunting this leery carnivore and taking one home is an accomplishable task. Trail cams all ow you to see what color variations and size that are available and to be setup early and with planning allow you to take the wolf hide of your dreams.

Fly in fishing is the way to get to areas that have larger than big fish, but Huge fish. Again, the fishes age is the key to his size. Extremely low fishing pressure makes them less leery and larger, the age is older and their summer growth per year is minimal but they have the years to grow.

### **Whitetail Deer Hunts**

**This is one of the top 3 Trophy Whitetail Deer location in the whole Alberta. Annually we take 2-3 massive Whitetail Bucks breaking the 200 marks.**

Our deer camps are located in Northern Alberta bordering farm & Crown land.

Heated tower stands and ground blinds are provided and set up in areas that B&C deer frequent. A lot of time and effort are put into maintaining our successful hunting areas and many trail cams are regularly maintained and monitored.

Bow or rifle deer hunts include transport to camp from Edmonton International Airport hotel, Guides, Food and Full-Service Lodging because there isn't much around except for us that is why the hunting is so good.

We boast a very high rate of success. All deer hunts are fair chase with 2 on 1 guides (1 on 1 guiding is available for an additional charge).

They can be hunted by different people if need be but 1 entity is responsible for the annual payment. There are very few bucks that leave our cam without being mounted when the hunter gets home. We take record bucks as a normal, not just now and then. For a group or association this can even be used as a raffle or a drawing to bring extra funds in each year.

### **Canadian Moose**

You can hear him coming. The grunting and smashing of everything in his path will make your hair stand on end. He's coming to defend his domain against all other bulls and those who are trying to challenge him. It gives you the feeling of fear and excitement all in one.

Moose hunting in the peak of rut is the most exciting adrenaline rush you could imagine.

By boat or canoe, along the lake and river, calling a bull is a very effective method.

All of our Moose camps are accessed by airplane only. This gives our hunters access to the most remote hunting areas where most of the game has never seen man before. Most of our moose camps are on lakes stocked with Great Northern Pike and Walleye. We provide comfortable cabin and wall tent camping at its best!

### **Alberta Timber Wolf and trapline**

Alberta Timber Wolves are the largest of the wolf species, sometimes up to 200 lbs. This elusive, cagey species are a thrill to hunt. Our wolf hunts are remote and accessed only by snowmobile. Heated blinds over bait piles or spot and stalk hunts are available. Warm cabin accommodations are provided. This is the most consistent way to bring home a trophy wolf. They are extremely smart but bait and trail cameras allow us to have wolves in a specific place in a more less consistent time. In addition, during mid-day it is time to run the trapline on Snow Mobiles if you wish.

World class Ice fishing is included with all wolf hunts. Cozy heated ice fishing tents are provided on lakes full of Walleye, Great Northern Pike and Lake Trout.
