TRANSFORMING SPACES: DESIGN FACTOR

The YMCA in Newport had a room that was completely transformed in two weeks. Working with 50 young people, community members and local businesses. The space was turned into a community cafe using all re-claimed materials. 10 young people gained skills in project management, working as teams, basic carpentry, painting, designing and basic construction. All presented with certificates at the end of the project supported by the University of South Wales.

Transforming Spaces: MIND ROCKS

Our construction projects transforms empty and unused spaces through working with the community on the planning, design and build. Working with build experts and volunteers from the community it acts like DIY SOS/60 minute makeover. The aim is to up skill young people and members of the community to gain on site experience.

The project will take place over a 6 week period and the young people will gain skills in:

- Health & Safety

- Health & Safety
 Planning & Design
 Making and Creating
 CV writing
 Enterprise &business skills
 Work with industry experts
 Learn about careers in the construction industry

This project has been postponed due to COVID 19 and this will take place in September 2020 where we will plan, design and re-build an empty room turning the space into a Music room for the community. This project will train and up skill a team of 15 young people who are at risk of offending to re-build the space learning construction skills.
