

Roles and responsibilities

Deacon with responsibility for - Children under 16 and families: Sue

"Deacons shall, with the Minister(s) (if any), be responsible for the leadership of the church, the fulfilment of its purpose, the pastoral care of its members and its day-to-day management and administration"

Being a Trustee of the church - Churches are subject to the requirements of charity law and therefore must have Trustees. As a Deacon, you are one of the Trustees, which comes with some important legal responsibilities.

Decision making - Deacons are expected to make decisions. Taking decisions is part of being a church leader. Deacons, acting together after prayer and consultation, are expected to give a lead to the church.

Meetings – Deacons are required to attend Church members meetings and AGM. Priories deacons Meetings and away days, where possible.

- Produce termly Rotas for Live Wires
- Appoint team leaders and support workers for Live Wire's and Switch
- Research and formulate new teaching resources, to keep our learning current.
- Be pastorally responsible for regularly attending families with young people under the age of 16.
- Develop relationships with families within the church and the local community.
- Help to develop a team of leaders for the children section in a Sunday service.
- Be a point of contact for new families attending FVFC.
- Ensure all Sunday School personnel hold a current DBS.
- Plan regular training and skills updates for Sunday school team leaders.
- Set a yearly budget for Live Wires and Switch (with the help of MK and CK)
- Deacon responsible/point of contact for Messy Church, Open House.
