I know that visiting a new church can be very daunting. You will find many friendly people here and as a small church you can fit in very quickly, should you choose to return.

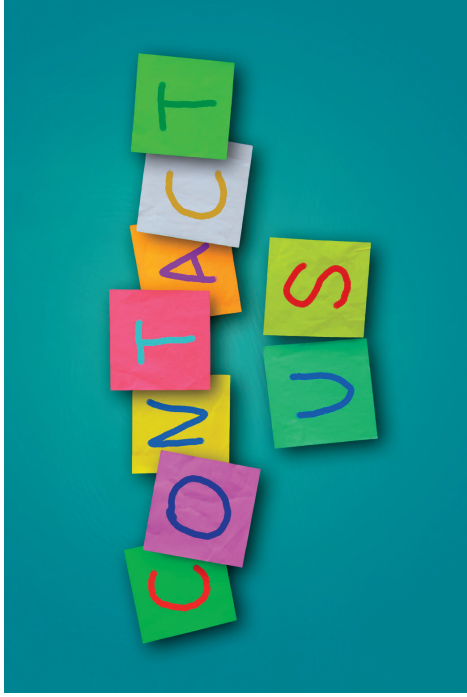

  - Where the unchanging message of the Gospel is communicated in words and actions that are relevant to our community today.

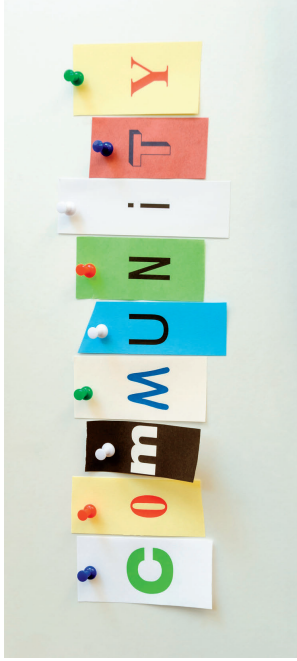
