PRIVATE LESSONS ARE NOT INCLUDED IN UNLIMITED CLASS FEES You will be receiving your bill/statement via email each month from us. If you do not receive statements each month, please let us know.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKING YOUR MONTHLY PAYMENTS!

COSTUME DEPOSITS OF \$25 PER COSTUME WILL BE DUE WITH DECEMBER TUITION AND REMAINING COSTUME BALANCES WILL BE DUE WITH MARCH TUITION.

We will do everything in our power to keep these costs to a minimum while making our dancers look fantastic on stage!

Recital tights and accessories will be ordered by "Twist and Shout" to ensure uniformity on stage. The cost of these items will be included in your total costume balance due.

All nine monthly payments will be due no later than the 5th of each month and are based on a flat school-year rate.

A LATE FEE OF 10% WILL BE CHARGED IF ACCOUNTS ARE NOT PAID ON TIME. A \$25 FEE WILL BE CHARGED FOR ANY RETURNED CHECKS.

Payments may be made by cash (please place in envelope marked with child's first and last name), check (please mark child's first and last name in the memo area of your check), automatic withdrawal (preferred method) OR VENMO @StephanieDenby1. With automatic withdrawal you will attach a voided check to your ACH form when signing up and all payments will come directly from your account starting in October. ACH NEEDS TO BE SIGNED UP FOR ANNUALLY!

SEPTEMBER TUITION AND REGISTRATION FEES WILL NEED TO BE PAID BY CHECK, CASH OR VENMO. THE LAST DAY TO SIGN UP FOR A NEW CLASS OR MOVE TO A DIFFERENT CLASS IS DECEMBER 1ST! NO EXCEPTIONS!

However, we do understand that there may be some situations that occur, and the need may arise to discontinue lessons. In these cases, we will require a **30-DAY WRITTEN NOTICE TO WITHDRAW**. If costumes have already been ordered when you quit, then you will be responsible for any balance still do for them.

Add/drop forms are available at the studio.

We try to place students in the best, most challenging and appropriate classes for them. Sometimes the teacher will determine that a student needs placement in a more advanced or less advanced class than they are currently in. This is not done without careful consideration. All changes will be made before the end of November. Remember you are paying us to teach your child.

IT IS IMPORTANT FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS TO UNDERSTAND THAT DANCE CLASS IS NOT THE SAME AS YOUR GRADE IN SCHOOL. In most cases the class will progress as a group but not always. Every child will be challenged in each class to compete against themselves not others.

We want all our students to have an enjoyable and educational learning experience. We will treat you and your children with courtesy and respect. We expect our students and parents to show the same attitude toward their teachers and fellow dancers.

We would still like to limit the number of people gathering in our lobby area. If possible, please drop your child at the door and pick them up when their class is over. Remind them to be careful in the parking lot.

We ask that if you absolutely must stay with your child that only one adult family member enter the building. If your child is under 5 then one adult family member will be allowed to stay in the lobby. (It is okay for student's siblings to stay in the lobby with the adult.)

Tumbling Turtles classes require ONE parent to participate with each student until December when we will start moving the parents out of the classroom to prepare the kids for recital. If your child is able to participate without you in the room earlier than December, then feel free to wait in the lobby.

For all pre-level classes one parent may remain in the lobby during class but NO parents will be allowed in the classrooms.

We ask you to please keep your child home if they have a fever, any Covid symptoms or if they have had exposure to Covid so that other children are not exposed. Our rule is 24 hours fever free just like the schools. This is more important now than it has ever been. Please help keep everyone safe!

If your child has lice, please do not send them back to classes until it is cleared up.

Dress code information is available on our website.

Most of our instructors are available for private lessons if you are interested. Please email twistandshoutdance@yahoo.com letting Stephanie know what type of private lesson you would like to and she will check instructor availability. You may also ask your

child's instructor directly if they have any availability. The fees for private lessons vary by instructor and all checks should be made out to the individual instructor.

Several of our instructors are students themselves. As part of their schooling there will be times that they will have other obligations for school and will not be able to make it to teach their classes. This is something we can not avoid but they will try not to miss classes. If they do need to miss a class, they will have a substitute teacher teach for them.

All clientele gives their permission to Twist and Shout to use their students' photographs and/or videos for promotional purposes (website, flyers, ads, etc.)

NO CHILDREN ARE ALLOWED IN THE DANCE ROOMS OR GYM UNLESS SUPERVISED BY STAFF
