Please wear comfortable clothing as you may need to remove any articles of clothing necessary for your Physio to examine and treat you.

You may be given an exercise programme which is structured to help you achieve your goal and which we recommend you follow.

Your Treatment Room will be wiped down between each visit and ventilated.
