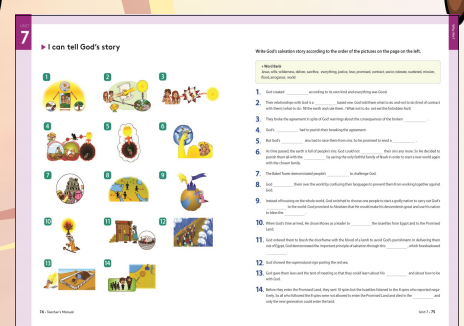
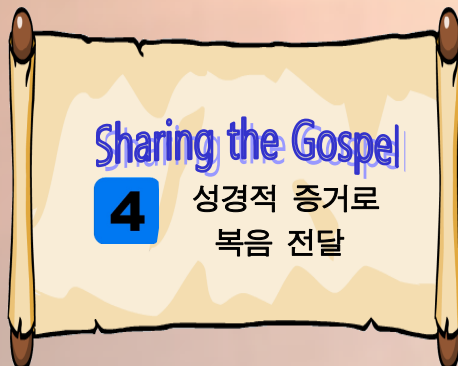
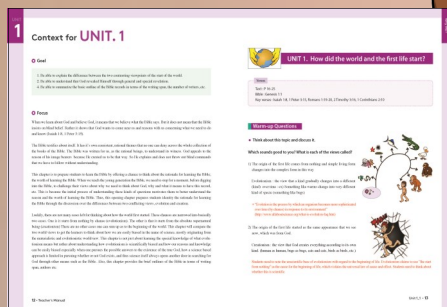

차세대에게 복음을 소개하고 교육시킬 때 우선시 해야 할 것

1) 복음은 간단하면서도 깊다. (Simple and Deep)

“예수 천당 불신 지옥”, 또는 “무조건적인 믿음”의 단순 논리와 맹목적 접근 방식으로 복음의 의미를 축소하여 가르치는 교육은 성숙한 신앙인으로 키워내는데 도움이 되지 않는다. 성경 전체가 증거하는 복음의 의미와 “왜 믿을 수 밖에 없는지”에 대한 하나님의 논리를 성경이 어떻게 증거하고 있는지 깊게 배울 수 있어야 한다. (벧전 3:15, 롬 1:20)

2) 복음은 신약으로만 다 설명될 수 없다. (Progressive and Consistent)

복음의 계시는 선택된 족속을 통해 인류 역사상에 점진적으로, 일괄적으로 제시 되어 온 하나님 열심의 결정체다. 성경 전체에서 들어나는, 약속을 근거로, 예언의 선포와 실현을 통해 하나님의 구속사적인 계획이 어떻게 펼쳐지고 완성했는지 전체 큰 그림을 수 있는 안목 (성경적 세계관)을 키울 수 있어야 한다. (눅 24:25-27, 요한 5:39)

3) 성경은 모든 내용을 다 기록하지 않았다. (Sufficiency vs. Exhaustive)

(요한 21:25, 로마서 11:33-36)

현대 물질만능주의의 기준으로만 성경을 제 멋대로 분석, 해석하는 왜곡된 해석이 차세대에게 심각한 영향을 주고 있다. 그렇다고 이런 문제들을 타파별로 변증하는 방식만으로는 복음의 본질에 다가설 수 없다. 성경이 구원에 필요한 필수적인 것은 충분히 전해 주고 있지만 인간의 논리에 100% 맞추어 모든 것을 기록하려는 의도는 맞고 있지 않다. 분명히 알 수 있고 바꿀 수 없는 굵직한 뼈대 같은 부분과 여전히 인간의 지식만으로는 접근하기에는 어려운 희미한 부분이 동시에 존재한다. 이런 경우는 성경을 통해 분명하게 제시 되는 굵은, 큰, 뼈대를 가장 먼저 분명하게 파악하고 그것을 기준으로 더 깊은 이해가 필요한 부분을 해석할 수 있어야 한다. 그래야 편견이나, 왜곡된 관점에 속지 않고 하나님의 진실을 제대로 바라볼 수 있기 때문이다. 그 분명한 뼈대가 사람이나, 전통, 문화가 만들어낼 수 있는 것인지, 아니면 오직 하나님의 역사 하심으로 만 가능할 수 있는 것인지를 발견하고 고백하게 되면, 이해 안 되는 부분은 더 이상의 혼돈과 왜곡이 아니라, 깊이로 보이기 때문이다.

What is our challenge?

The most serious problem that the young generation has faced nowadays is the biblical illiteracy, which is almost getting epidemic more than before. This is also true of the teachers and parents who lack the sufficient knowledge of the Bible that is necessary not only for teaching young generation about the whole-Bible context of Gospel but also training them to defend their faith against the secularism that has played a significant role of distorting the faith of next generation. It is important to help the young generations to understand what the whole Bible testifies itself about Jesus, when they try to seek the rationale for their faith in Jesus. The teaching of the whole picture of the Bible provides many meaningful benefits. First, it helps the next generation to learn the trustworthy of Bible that flows as planned only possibly by divine power, not by any human being since the Bible testifies itself in terms of how each of the contents in the Bible supports the major theme of the Bible consistently over the long extended time period. It helps to see God's faithfulness in keeping his promise to send Savior to us in very precise and specific ways. When the young generation realize that the whole picture of the Bible about God's redemptive plan through Jesus Christ has been wonderfully and miraculously witnessing its fulfillment, their faith would stand firmer on the biblical testimony. 13. What name was given to memorialize this event and for what purpose?

God commanded the Israelites to commemorate day, for the generations to come. This is called the Passover.

This event is also designed to teach about the seriousness of sin. The only way to become clean from sin is through the sacrifice of another sinless life, representing the coming Jesus. Passover has been observed the longest in the world up to now. (around 3,500 years)

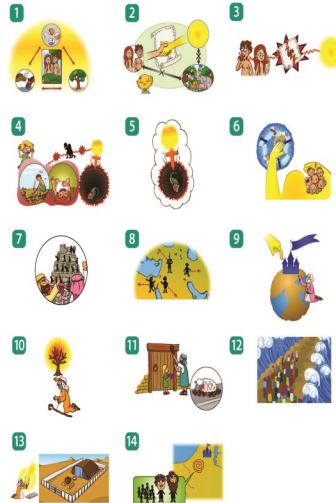

Since God is love, can't He just forgive the people without requiring these steps?

Of course, God can. However, He wants to teach us the weight of sin with this visual system of sacrifice.

Sin broke the relationship between God and man and death entered the world through it. The sin of man and the justice of God can't mix, like water and oil, so the people had to learn the seriousness of sin.

So God showed how to solve the problem of sin. In order to forgive the sin that caused the death of an eternal life, there had to be a sacrifice of such a life that symbolizes the sinlessness.

That special solution is the offering of sacrifice. Whenever the people sinned, this sacrifice had to be repeated.

What we can learn from offerings of sacrifice:

- The Holiness of God
- The weight of sin
- God's forgiving mercy and love.

God had already shown the way to wash away sins in Egypt. The blood of the lamb on the door posts had protected the lives of the firstborns.
