Our camps offer your child a week of total immersion in all things equine. For the first five days of each session students will ride one to two times a day, and participate in activities designed to help them learn about safety, horsemanship, stable management and equine anatomy. On the final day students will demonstrate their new skills and present their project at a mini horse show held at the barn. We have four instructors plus additional interns to staff our camp program.

Regular Camp Sessions Minimum age is 6 years old. Regular Camp Session Cost is \$675 per student with a \$325

<u>deposit</u> due when you return the attached registration form. We will provide lunch and snacks. Students should bring plenty of water every day. In addition, each student must have an approved helmet, boots, and appropriate riding pants (breeches or jeans). Riding gloves are optional. Our Regular Camp Sessions are Monday-Friday, 8:00a to 4p. Graduation on Saturday is from 9am-11am approximately.

Pee Wee Camp Session. Campers ages 4-6 years old are welcome. Pee Wee Session Cost is \$475 per student with a \$250 deposit due when you return the attached registration form. We will provide snacks. Please bring plenty of water every day. In addition, each student must have an approved helmet, boots, and appropriate riding pants (breeches or jeans). Riding gloves are optional. Our Pee Wee Camp sessions are Monday through Friday, 8:00a to 12p. Graduation on Saturday Is from 9am-11am approximately.

<u>Half Day Camp</u> is open to any student 6 or over that wishes to leave camp at noon. <u>Cost is \$475 per student with \$250 deposit.</u>

Advanced Rider Camp your student must be approved by an MMS Instructor to attend this week of camp. Advanced Camp can be added to any week of camp, provided we have a minimum of 3 advanced campers. A list of required skills is available if you need assistance determining if your rider is advanced. Cost is \$675 with a deposit of \$325 due when you return the form.

Show Team Camp and Advanced Show Team Camp are by invitation only. Cost for this camp is \$600 with a \$300 deposit and will only be offered on the weeks above marked with *.

Siblings attending the same camp, and students who attend more than one session this summer, are eligible for a \$25 discount for the second student or for each additional camp in the same summer. There's an additional \$25 discount if you register and pay the deposit by April 30.
