I left for my “home away from home” in Fairmont City late last Sunday afternoon, April 7, with the intention of viewing the Solar Eclipse “outside the path of totality.” My brother, Gene, insisted that I do otherwise. So, on Monday, April 8, we traveled. (at times very slowly) to Nashville (IL, surprise, surprise!) to see this celestial phenomenon. Once here, however, Gene called our cousins in Scheller; he asked if we could join the three of them at their farm. They said yes — and further down the road we went. Wearing our safety glasses, we all agreed that the Eclipse was “totally” awesome. This event reminded me (and you, too?) of Luke 23: 44-47, “It was now about noon and darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon *because of an eclipse of the sun.* Then the veil of the temple was torn down the middle. Jesus cried out in a loud voice, ‘Father, into your hands I commend my spirit;’ and when He had said this He breathed His last. The centurion who witnessed what had happened glorified God and said, ‘This Man was innocent beyond doubt.’ ” The Darkness of His Death leads to the Glory of our Resurrection!
