FRESH FROM THE MIND OF FR. ANDY

Our Parish Partnership Deacon Fred Sterns, Jr., and his 2023 Classmates — Deacons Jay Fowler, Brad Haar, James Keepes, Anthony Kellerman, Daniel Kimutis, Daniel Laquet, Douglas Lugge, David Mills, David Miskell, William Mueller, Leonard Ratajczyk, Thomas Ritzheimer, and Justin Wolfslau have nearly finished celebrating the Paschal or Easter Triduum (Latin for “Three Days”) for the first time as ordained ministers of the Roman Catholic Church. May their experience of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday, viewed from a new perspective of the Light of Christ, been amazingly grace-filled for them, their wives, and their families. Pray for Deacon Fred and his collared colleagues as they complete 10 months (April 3) of dedicated service to God and to God’s people throughout the Diocese of Belleville.

I was present at the Chrism Mass (to which everyone was invited) this past Tuesday, March 26, at St. Peter’s Cathedral in Belleville. No exception to the rule, our Bishop, Most Reverend Michael G. McGovern, was the Principal Celebrant and Homilist, at the Eucharist. Incorporated within this particular Eucharistic celebration was the Renewal of Priestly Promises by all priests in attendance (including Yours Truly); this renewal happened by way of two questions asked of us by Bishop McGovern. Yet, as the title *Chrism Mass* suggest, there was a higher purpose for this assembly of believers. Published in the program booklet was the following: “The Bishop is to be regarded as the High Priest of his flock, from whom the life in Christ of his faithful is in some way derived and upon whom it depends. The Chrism Mass, which he concelebrates with Priests from various regions of the diocese and during which he consecrates the sacred Chrism Oil and blesses two other oils, is among the principal manifestations of the fullness of the Bishop’s Priesthood and is considered to be a sign of the close bond of the Priests with him. For it is with sacred Chrism oil, consecrated by the Bishop, that the newly baptized are anointed and those to be confirmed are signed. It is with the Oil of Catechumens that individuals are prepared and disposed for Baptism. Finally, it is with the Oil of the Sick that those who are ill are comforted in their infirmity” (Introduction, *The Order of Blessing the Oil of Catechumens and of the Sick and of Consecrating the Chrism*, United States Conference of Catholic Bishops 2019, 1-2).
