The parish finance council met on Thursday February 27th. We are financially stable, but we are a little bit down this year financially. Our Sunday envelopes usage is down \$5,326.82. Our plate collection is down \$12,232.09. Overall for the year after our expenses have been paid, we are down \$10,773.30. God willing we will make it up in the coming weeks so that we will end the fiscal year even. I can't thank you enough for your support of our parish and school!

Our parking lot will be repaved starting Tuesday April 14th. This will take four days to do. There will be no change to our mass schedule, the parking lot will be off limits however. This money will come from our Called to Renew Campaign Funds. After that, we will be replacing our sound system followed by renovating the confessionals. God is good!

BIBLE STUDY IN SPANISH

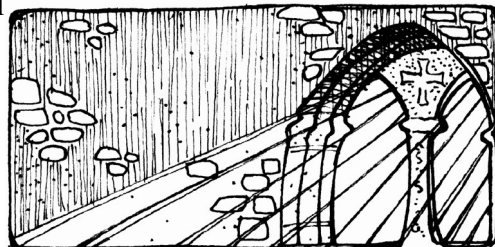
Bible Study (IN SPANISH) with Monsignor Herres will take place each Monday at 7:45pm in the school. All are invited to join. Bring your Bibles.
