CATHOLIC SCHOOLS...DID YOU KNOW?

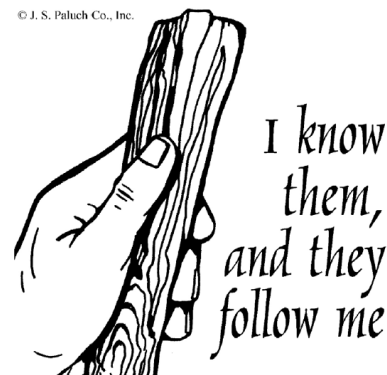
