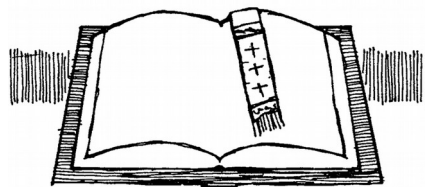


### BOXTOPS FOR EDUCATION
