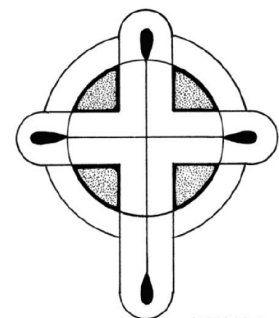
December 8th is a Holy Day of Obligation as we celebrate The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We will have four masses for your convenience. We will have a Vigil Mass on Tuesday December 7th at 5:00pm. On Wednesday December 8th we will have three masses at 8:00am, 5:00pm, and 7:00pm. All Catholics are required to go to mass. I hope to see you there.

This Friday December 3rd is First Friday. We will have Confession in the evening from after the 5:00pm mass until 6:30pm. We will also have extra times for adoration from 8:30am until 12:00pm and from after the 5:00pm mass until 8:00pm.

One of the best ways to prepare for Christmas is by going to Confession. We have Confession every Saturday Morning here at Holy Trinity from 8:45am until 9:30am. If that does not work for you, check out the schedule of the local parishes. On Tuesday December 14th Incarnation will be having a Penance Service. I along with other priests in the deanery will be there for that. We will offer confession also on Friday December 17th from after the 5:00pm mass until 6:30pm. Do not wait to receiver this beautiful sacrament.

Simbang Gabi 2021 is around the corner. Our evening celebration will run from 12/15-12/23, weekdays at 7:00pm and weekends at 5:00pm. Our morning celebration will run from 12/16-12/24 daily at 5:00am.

DID YOU KNOW?

Parents have a responsibility to report concerns they have about another person’s behaviors or actions that could put their children — or any children — at risk. These concerns are anything that makes the parent uneasy or uncomfortable, or anything that a child reports made them feel uneasy or uncomfortable. Some examples of seemingly little things that can be worth reporting include: A teacher covering her glass classroom door with artwork, eliminating the ability to see into the classroom from the hall; a youth ministry icebreaker activity, where teens have to pass a mint candy from person to person using only toothpicks in their mouth, despite the discomfort of some participants.
