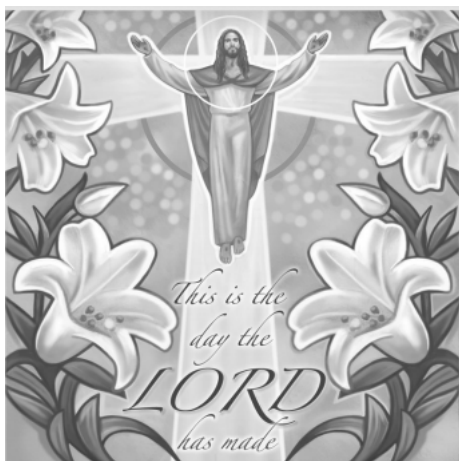
The deposit amount for Third Sunday of Easter was \$10,502.00. Thank you for your generosity and continued support of Holy Trinity Parish.
