SUNDAY OFFERINGS

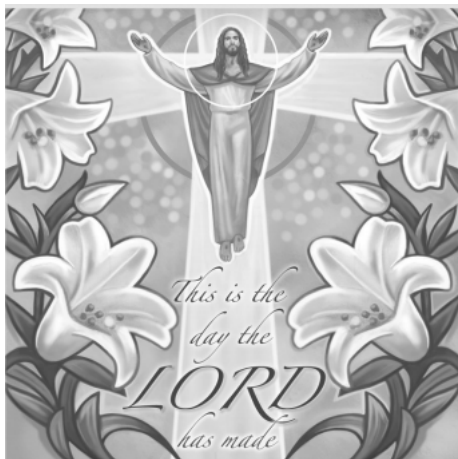
The deposit amount for the Palm Sunday was \$11,424.00. Thank you for your generosity and continued support of Holy Trinity Parish.
