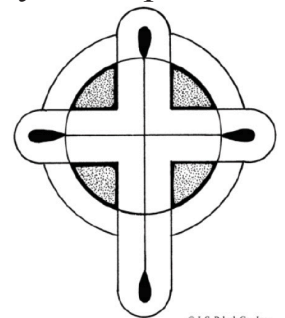

Trained adults can take steps to prevent suspicion. The Protecting God's Children program is in place to raise awareness about behaviors of adults that may indicate a threat to the safety of children and young people. Through this program, trained adults learn how to prevent abuse from happening, in part by taking steps to eliminate suspicious behaviors, such as being alone with a young person. Feast of Corpus Christi

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ was instituted by Urban in 1264. The feast is often celebrated with processions of the Holy Eucharist accompanied with St. Thomas Aquinas hymns of Pange Lingua, Tantum Ergo. Panis Angelicus and O Salutaris Hostia.
