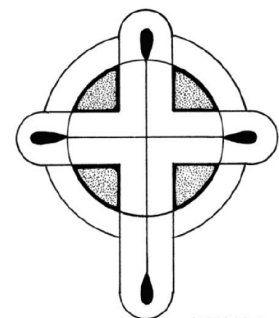

Holy Trinity Parish’s Safeguard the Children Committee plays a crucial role in assuring that the safeguard initiatives found in the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops’ Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People have been made a priority in our parish and school and that the Archdiocesan safe environment programs, policies and procedures are being implemented throughout our parish/school community. All adults over the age of 18 who are involved in volunteer ministry with children must attend a mandatory training session called Protecting God’s Children. This initial 2 ½ hour training session will be offered in our parish on Saturday, August 14th at 2:00pm or Thursday, September 2nd at 6:30pm. The certificate from this class is good for 4 years. If you need to re-certify, a Keeping the Promise Alive class will be offered in our parish on Saturday, August 28th at 2:30pm or Thursday, September 9th at 6:30pm. These classes are for adults over the age of 18 only and are held upstairs in the 6th Grade Classroom. Space is limited and a reservation is required.
