The ensemble has won numerous prices in Poland and internationally. It has also accompagny during two consecutive years the internationally renowned Polish singer Piotr Rubik in tours in the United States of America and Canada.

He is now a music teacher in Wroclaw and orgnaist for the parish of his native town, Brzeg.
