The orchestra of the professional conservatory of music “Muñoz Molleda” is compounded with students specialized in orchestral studies. The group has travelled and played across Andalusia but also France and Austria. The ensemble played numerous concerts by interpreting famous musical work such as the ones of Gluck, Mozart, Ravel, Tchaïkovski, Beethoven, Strauss as well as Vivaldi. The students are trained to reach the greatest result, thus the high level of the orchestra was a key factor for the election of the Muñoz Molleda Conservatory of professional music as the first Spanish conservatory within the network of schools partnered with the UNESCO.
