She is conducting since 2016 the chamber orchestra of Mexico, as well as the Salesian symphonic orchestra of young people, since 2001. Lizzi Cenicerros has received many prizes, for instance the prize “Mexican Women” in 2015, or the prize “Mexico in your hands” in 2016, and has received in recognition of her professional career the medal of the federal university of Latin American integration in 2017.
