JAVIER SÁNCHEZ CASTILLO

Javier Sánchez Castillo was born in Úbeda in 1998, he started his studies in the María de Molina music Conservatory at 12 years old. Six years later, in 2016, he won the public prize of the A category young soloist contest of the Conservatory María de Molina. During the same year, his was a member of the orchestra of young people of the South of Spain and played in various other orchestras. He also performed at the music festival Ciudad de Úbeda as a soloist. After he passed his first year at the Conservatory de Castilla- La Mancha, he is now pursuing the second year at the Conservatory of Castile and León.
