Camerata de Esquina is a string ensemble, made up of young music students from the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (UNIRIO). The young musicians are working to develop a program that includes various types of Brazilian music.

With nearly 2 years of experience, Camerata de Esquina has already achieved important results, such as the first prize in the chamber music competition of the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (UNIRIO) and the prize for the best chamber musician for Camerata's first violin, Ágatha Lima. The ensemble has also performed in major institutions and concert halls in Rio de Janeiro.

In February 2018, Camerata de Esquina took part in the *Gramado In Concert* International Festival in Brazil. They have performed in various parts of the city and have attended chamber music classes with renowned teachers.

The group also participated in the Eurochestries Festival in Quebec (Canada) in 2018. Back in Rio de Janeiro, Camerata de Esquina won third place in the 8th Chamber Music Competition of the famous Villa-Lobos Festival.
