

#### Rabbi Gabrielle Cohn

Prior to college and rabbinical school at Hebrew Union College (HUC) in New York, Rabbi Cohn (who grew up in Virginia) lived in Jackson, Mississippi where she worked at the Goldring/Woldenberg Institute of Southern Jewish Life (ISJL) as an Education Fellow, traveling around the Southern United States, consulting with congregational religious schools of all sizes. She attended Columbia University and the Jewish Theological Seminary's (JTS) Joint Program - List College, and graduated Cum Laude with a BA in Psychology and Modern Jewish Studies in 2016.During her 5 years at HUC, she has gained considerable additional experience filling various Rabbinic Intern positions in New York (New Rochelle, Cutchogue, Mamaroneck, White Plains); Florida (Coral Gables); Virginia (Falls Church) and Israel. Her leadership training and experience is extensive including holding a JTS Fellowship in Social Jewish Entrepreneurship from Sept 2015 - May 2016. Since 2007 Rabbi Cohn has served in continuous youth and adult Jewish Studies positions throughout New York, Virginia, New Jersey, California, and Mississippi.While completing her studies at HUC, Rabbi Gabi has continued to serve as a Judaic Studies and Hebrew Teacher/Bnai Mitzvah Tutor at Central Synagogue in New York. She is a member of the Board of Trustees of the Jewish Braille Institute (JBI) International, holds a Masters in Hebrew Literature from HUC and expects to be Ordained in May 2024 after completing her thesis: Jewish Perspectives on Blindness Over History.




