Second Sunday of Easter | Divine Mercy Sunday ~ April 7, 2024

On Divine Mercy Sunday, Year B, the readings show God's endless mercy towards us. The first reading tells how early Christians shared everything, living in unity. The second reading emphasizes that loving God and obeying His commandments are signs of our faith, which conquers the world. Divine Mercy Chaplet

The Divine Mercy Chaplet is a powerful prayer focusing on God's mercy, often recited on Divine Mercy Sunday, which follows Easter. This prayer invites us to reflect on Jesus' immense love and mercy towards humanity. It's recited using rosary beads and includes specific prayers given by Jesus to Saint Faustina Kowalska, emphasizing trust in God's mercy and the offering of that mercy to others. Praying the chaplet on Divine Mercy Sunday is a special devotion, highlighting the depth of God's love and the forgiveness

available to all, aligning perfectly with the day's themes of renewal and divine compassion.
