Little Annie's Hope Train is a 501(c)3 nonprofit that is devoted to lending Northeast Ohioans in need a helping hand while preserving their dignity and worth. Through our mission, we want to remove the stigma of need while remembering to see the person and not the struggle. Our goal is that one day those that we have helped will be able to pass on that gift.

The services that Little Annie's Hope Train provides to the community are numerous: seeking out and assisting those living in the elements with food and survival items, setting up "caring walls," stocking 19 freestanding little pantries in Lake and Geauga counties, bringing sack lunches to women's and men's shelters in Cleveland, helping homeless people secure a birth certificate or state ID card, offering school supplies for children in need, purchasing beds for children who've never had their own, and providing a short-term hotel stay for those who have been living on the street. These services are always expanding as the needs of our community are ever-changing.
