Please keep a copy of this registration form for your information. We are capping the camp at 25 so please contact me before submitting application to be sure there is still room! Chamber music groups will be formed, and music will be sent out via PDF four weeks before the camp. For seating and part assignments, students are required to submit a short video of their playing due May 20th, 2024, to assist us in assigning parts and chamber groups (please see below). One idea is to submit a video recording of the student's Solo & Ensemble performance.

Cello Haven is open to students aged 13-18. Students going into high school and recent graduates are welcome.

We have made arrangements to hold the camp at the Colombiere Conference Center, about halfway between Detroit and Flint in Michigan. Colombiere opened as a Jesuit training facility in 1959 and currently serves as a conference and retreat center. It is surrounded with acres of towering pines, oaks, and walking trails. We have made every effort to keep the cost as low as possible. The following costs cover everything: room and board (includes 2 nights, 7 meals), all the classes, chamber music coachings, cello orchestra, and the concert. There is also a lower fee for commuters (see below).

Cost of room and board (Lodging is Monday and Tuesday nights, 7 meals lunch to lunch):

- Single with private bathroom: \$352.00 per person, per stay (limited availability).
- Single without private bathroom: \$322.00 per person, per stay.
- Double room with private bathroom (only available with specific roommate request, see <u>below</u>): \$322.00 per person, per stay.
- Double room without private bathroom (<u>only available with specific roommate request, see</u> <u>below</u>): \$312.00 per person, per stay.

All room requests are based on availability at time of registration.

If you choose a room without a private bath, public shower facilities include private shower stalls. Gender neutral, private bathrooms with private shower stalls are also available.

Commuters: \$160.00 + purchase of individual meals (Breakfast \$11.00, Lunch \$14.00, Dinner \$16.00).

NOTE: There is a Tuesday evening rehearsal 7-8:30 PM so commuters will need to be available at this time. There will also be a bonfire for the students after the rehearsal. There will also be some activities in the evening on Monday that commuters may want to attend.

Meals begin with Monday lunch and end with Wednesday lunch. <mark>The dining hall accommodates</mark> vegetarians, vegans, gluten free diets, and allergies.</mark> Please indicate special meal requests below.
