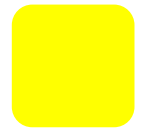

International Architectural **DESIGN AWARD**



The **S.ARCH International AWARD** is dedicated to the recognition of **Completed Projects and Conceptual Designs**, their excellence in architecture and/or urbanism, architectural diversity, new ideas and their exemplary implementations around the world.

The S.ARCH AWARD seeks to recognize new developments in sustainable architecture, where particular attention has been given to building schemes that use local resources and appropriate design solutions in innovative ways.

The S.ARCH AWARD pays tribute to encourage building concepts that successfully set new standards in architecture. It may challenge, drive and inspire architects to confront more with objective of architecture and its relationship with the environment.

The AWARD is evaluated by a professional jury from worldwide-recognised prominent international studios.

Who can Submit?

Individual architects, studios/practices, landscape architects, students and multi-professional teams. Developers, funders, contractors and other associated groups/institutions may also enter on behalf of the architect, with his/her approval.

What can be Submitted?

Completed Projects and/or **Conceptual Architectural Designs** of buildings and/or landscapes, in following design categories:

RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL/PUBLIC, SMALL PROJECTS, URBAN PROJECTS.

No specific criteria exist regarding type, location and/or costs of considered Project/Design.

Number of Projects/Designs that may be submitted is not limited.

SUBMISSION

- Filled Application form
- Two A2 posters/boards (in Adobe PDF landscape format)
Submitted poster/board must include only Project/Design name (and none of the information about names of architects, studios and/or collaborating parties), photos/images of the building/Design, a site plan, plans/drawings and approximately 250 words Project/Design description in English.
- The fee for the submission is 285 EUR (310 US\$) per Entry.
- All posters/boards have to be sent electronically to the S.ARCH team:

The responsible of the submission must be authorised/credited to use all included photos/ images and data.

All submitted information may be used on our website with proper references/citations.

All submissions acknowledge the Organisers of the **S.ARCH International Architecture AWARD** the right to reproduce photos/images, drawings and other information materials in whole or in part (with all sources properly referenced/cited and credited) in connection to the S.ARCH Conference and/or to

the **S.ARCH International Architecture AWARD** and/or to the International Journal of Contemporary Architecture "The New ARCH", as well as their promotion, without payment of copyright or without any other obligations to the responsible of the submission.

Attending the S.ARCH Conference

If the Project/Design is Short-Listed, one representative from the corresponding practice/studio **may** attend the S.ARCH - 2024 Conference in New York City (participation in the conference is **not obligatory**).

If the Project/Design wins an AWARD, at least one representative should be available to collect the trophy at the AWARDING CEREMONY.

The AWARDING CEREMONY will take place on March 26, 2024 in New York City.

Judging

All Projects for the Short-List as well as the winning one will be nominated anonymously. The decision of the jury is final.

The jury reserves the right to reject any submission not complying with the requirements of the competition. Details of the judgement processes and corresponding communications will not be disclosed to submissions on request.

The Jury will select the Winners for the following categories:

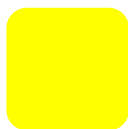
RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL / PUBLIC, SMALL PROJECTS, URBAN PROJECTS.
