Event Regulations

- 1- Border Motor Club will promote a Touring Car Assembly called the Border Classic 2024 on Sunday, May 19th 2024.
- 2- The event will start from Elsham Hall (4 miles north of Brigg)
- 3- The first car will leave at 10:31 am and entrants will leave at 1 minute intervals.
- 4- Route directions will be emailed 2 days before the event. For those who do not use computers, a printed copy is available if requested 5 days prior to the event.
- 5- The Event is open to classic cars manufactured before 2000, or at the organisers discretion for any vehicles of interest.
- 6- The minimum number of entries is 25 and the maximum entry is 80. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event in the unlikely event that the minimum entry is not reached.
- 7- UK entrants must ensure that the vehicle has, where required, a valid MOT test certificate, road tax & a valid certificate of insurance for the event.
- 8- The organisers reserve the right to exclude any vehicle which, in their opinion, is unsuitable for participation of the tour. Cars must not carry any competition numbers anywhere on the vehicle.
- 9- A Certificate of Exemption has been applied for from MSUK.
- 10- The Entry fee is £20 per vehicle. The closing date for entries is Sunday, May 12th 2024.
- 11- The route will be defined by a road book consisting of 'Tulip' drawings and both total and intermediate mileage. A map book should not be needed to complete the event.
- 12- The event will have a halfway halt. Basic catering is available at the halfway if desired (The route will be approx 100 miles)
- 13- Refreshments are available to purchase at both the start and finish venues, as well as the halfway venue. Details of the finish venue will be given in the final instructions, sent out prior to the event, if you wish to book a table at the finish venue for a meal.

15- Dogs are NOT allowed at the start venue due to them having animals on site.
