DeLoris Mae Hoffman was born was born in Ashley on February 19, 1942 to Christina (Wolf) and Gottlieb Hoffman. She was raised on a farm near Ashley and attended country school. She furthered her education at Ashley High School (Class of 1960) and Business College in Bismarck. DeLoris was united in marriage to Orion "Rudy" Rudolph at Zion Lutheran Church in Ashley on February 10, 1963. The couple first settled in Aberdeen, SD and she was employed by the South Dakota Highway Patrol. In 1975, the Rudolphs moved to Ashley, where she lived for the rest of her life. For a brief time, she was employed at the McIntosh County Bank. In 1978, she began a nearly 40-year employment career as the McIntosh County Emergency Manager. DeLoris was a member of Zion Lutheran Church and volunteered with the lady's circle groups. She was also the president and a fundraiser for the Ashley Senior Citizens. Her hobbies included playing computer card games and keeping in touch with old friends on Facebook. She enjoyed entertaining, having coffee with friends, telling jokes, and playing competitive games of Rook with her neighbors. DeLoris died with her family by her side at her home Sunday morning, June 25, 2023. She attained the age of 81 years, four months, and seven days.
