Highland Pony Breed Society Bronze Medal

Overall In-Hand Champion Bronze Medal

The medal is presented to the exhibitor of the winning pony providing they are a Society member and the registered keeper (owner/HPS official loanee) of the pony. The award is not taken down the line if the winner is not a member."

This show is a qualifier for the 2024 Highland Pony Society Young stock Championship

RULES

The committee reserve the right to refuse entry

The Judge's decision is final

Ponies entered in all classes must be registered with the Highland Pony Society in the Full Stud Book or Appendices A, B & C. Part Breds must be registered with the HPS in the Part Bred register. (foals are eligible if awaiting registration)

Ponies must not exceed 14.2 (148cm)

Over height ponies may only be entered in training, concour and fancy dress classes

Ponies must be shown in their natural state as per HPS showing recommendations

Correctly secured British standard hats/skulls must be worn at all times when mounted with the chinstrap secured. Any competitor whose hat comes off or chinstrap comes undone whilst competing must, on penalty of elimination, replace it before continuing. He /She may dismount without penalty to recover the hat or have it passed up from the ground, or may stop to refasten the hat.

Behaviour by an exhibitor or his servants deemed to be unsporting or unreasonable, or any animal which, in the opinion of the judge, is deemed to be out of control will be requested to be removed from the ring or show-ground and may cause all rosettes, prize money, and entry fees to be withheld.

Objections must be lodged with the Secretary in writing, accompanied by £25 within 30 Minutes of the class conclusion. Money will be returned if the objection is upheld.

All foals must be 4 weeks old or over on the day of the show.

A novice pony must not have been placed 1st in an open class up to the day of the show.

The committee reserve the right to combine/split classes at its discretion

It will be a condition of entry that the following apply. The Show Committee shall not be liable for any dam-ages to persons, animals or property or exhibitors may sustain during the show. Each entrant must agree to indemnify the organisers of the Three Counties Showground against any legal action arising from incidents at the show.

All colts and Stallions over 2 years old must be bitted. All stallions over 4 years old must hold a Highland Pony Society Stallion Licence.

All entrants must be at the collecting ring 5 minutes before the class is due to start unless otherwise stated

No spurs allowed to be worn whilst being judged

No stallions must be shown In Hand or Under Saddle by children under 15 years of age.

In event of cancellation entry fees will be refunded less 20% administration - we have the right to amalgamate classes, change judges and only offer refunds with a Vets Certificate

DOGS—for reasons of safety and to prevent nuisance dogs can only be permitted on the showground on a lead,

PLEASE CLEAR UP AFTER YOUR DOG.

STABLING—is subject to availability on a first come first served basis.

All persons entering the Show must have Personal and Public Liability Insurance The Malvern Highland Pony Show will not be responsible for any damage, loss or injury to any animal, person or property whilst on the showground. Under no circumstances must anyone other than Judges, Stewards, Competitors, Grooms or those with permission from the Committee enter the Show Rings
