



THE WILD TREK

Adapted to any level, from beginners to experienced riders.

Period : from mid-November to late March.

Age : adults and children over 9 years of age.

Session length : 6 hours.

Time spent riding : 3 hours.

Paces : walk and trot, canter according to ability of each rider.

An experience to get to know a herd and build a relationship with your horse.

From the first contact with your horse until its return among the herd after the trek, all the information provided will help you understand this wonderful animal, who will become, for a while, a travelling companion with whom you can share a beautiful story.

Each rider will pick out his horse from the paddock and will take care of the horse before and after the ride, so that a real exchange between horse and rider can take place.

ROUTE : From the hamlet of Vénasclé to the Vigurie de la Clue, off the beaten track. A break time is organised at the Viguerie to have a picnic around a little fire (weather permitting). The return trip follows the bed of the Vallonge stream.

SCHEDULE : Meeting at Vénasclé at **10:00 am**, end of the session around **4:00 pm**.

POINTS OF INTEREST : the wide-open spaces of the wild plateaux of Montdenier that overlook the lac de Sainte-Croix, la Viguerie de la Clue.

HIGHLIGHTS : This trek's route is very varied : it allows the beginner rider to improve quickly, and the experienced rider to enjoy some cantering.

PRICE : 75 € per person.

The price includes :

- Hire of an equipped horse.
- The monitoring of the session by a certified equestrian tourism professional.
- Loan of a helmet (wearing a helmet is compulsory).

Payment at the centre : cheque or cash.

Remote payment : cheque or bank transfer.

Reservation required.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

CLOTHING : Long trousers, closed shoes, coat. Clothing must be warm and comfortable. The rider must be in good physical condition.

BRING WITH YOU : a picnic, 1 litre of water per person, camera, sunscreen (saddlebags are provided for your personal belongings).

WEATHER : In case of rain or showers, the trek will take place and we will provide raincoats adapted for riders. If the weather is judged to make the activity impossible and we take the decision to cancel the ride, we offer another date for the trek, or a refund.

INSURANCE : The centre is covered for its own civil responsibility. We advise you to check with your own insurance. We also offer a personal "stopover rider" insurance.

We also offer other services :

- ✓ Canoe trips into the Verdon gorges.
- ✓ Horseback and canoe packages.
- ✓ On site accommodation, in our "lodge" tents (from June to early September ; B&B or half-board).
