Intervention Programmes, Low to Medium Level Intervention.

These Intervention Programmes are aimed at students who are starting to demonstrate very early signs of disaffection, often due to changes in home/life circumstances; this is when early intervention can be most effective. Appropriate behaviours are consistently reinforced, and inappropriate ones effectively challenged. These courses are ideally suited to small groups; often single sex groups are more effective as they limit the fear of inhibitions. Course Content

Pre-school visit

Here we meet the group and put them at ease. Students complete a light-hearted but formative assessment which analyses their perceptions of the types of activities they will embark upon, and also their level of self-esteem. This, along with the opportunity to discuss the course and various needs of students with you and your staff, allows us to formulate a bespoke programme.

Activity Day

With an overriding respect for our environment and an ethos of leaving only footprints behind, we use natural venues for our days which generally are based on our journey model; any of our activities listed may be used depending on the group and their needs. All specialist equipment is provided including fibre pile clothing, water proofs and wellies or boots. Students will need to bring or be provided with a packed lunch/drink and they will need to wear their oldest stretchy clothes. The school will need to provide its' own transport and meet at a given venue within a one-hour drive from the school, normally by 10 a.m. returning in time for the end of the school day; a later return can always be arranged to extend the day if you are happy to do so.

Photographic and Video Evidence

Photographic and video records of their achievements and a picture-based certificate can be provided if required at a small additional charge. (*parental permission required on consent*)

Course Costs ('Pupil Premium Grant' may be a funding option).

Two-day course: -

One day followed by a break, then a second day following a consolidation period at school. Standard group size, a minimum of 8: £35 per person and one member of EDGE-ucation staff. (*Note: group size of 8 includes school staff, smaller groups might be necessary, cost as for min of 8*)

Three-day course: -

One day followed by a break, then another two days following a consolidation period at school. Standard group size, a minimum of 8: £33 per person and one member of EDGE-ucation staff. (*Note: group size of 8 includes school staff, smaller groups might be necessary, cost as for min of 8*)

Five-day course: -

One day and the remaining four days to suit the school and monitoring process. Standard group size, a minimum of 8: £31 per person and one member of EDGE-ucation staff. (*Note: group size of 8 includes school staff, smaller groups might be necessary, cost as for min of 8*)

Continuation/Top up days: -

Following monitoring of the group and individuals post course, extra input may be beneficial. This is priced at £31.00 per student, based on a group size of 8.
