The DofE recently modified the Award conditions at Bronze, this means that it is now possible to complete a Bronze Programme over four or five days.

The programme overleaf comprises a total of four days. The training is a mixture of some theory but is largely practically based.

As the training is over four days school staff will be provided with materials to cover aspects such as final planning, food and kit check over two twilight sessions at school.

All EDGE-ucation staff are very experienced at running and leading D of E. For the full scope and capabilities of experience please refer to our policy document 'I believe we have the most highly qualified and experienced staff of any other provider'.

## **Provision**

The costings below are for basic provision only, please add the costs below to the total price per student if required: -

Group equipment can be supplied, Expedition Tents, Trangia and Gas, please ask this to be added to the costings below if required at £20.00 per student. This must be decided and notified at the time of booking/deposit.

An agreement is required to cover the cost of damage to equipment loaned if above normal wear and tear.

Personal equipment is to be supplied by the student, but Rucksacks can be hired at £5 per day.

Camp site fees and any venue facilities are included.

Evening/Overnight supervision by **EDGE-ucation** staff on the final assessed expedition will finish when all groups have set up camp and cooked. **EDGE-ucation** staff will be on call overnight and within ten minutes of the camp. Please add £5 per student if full overnight supervision is required by EDGE-ucation staff, this must be decided and notified at the time of booking/deposit.

Assessment of the final expedition is included using accredited assessors. Assessment reports will be sent as a downloadable pdf file or if preferred directly to the student's e portal. We don't include transport in the costings below.

## Costings

Based on the above provision and programme the total cost is: - (see note on provision and supply of group equipment above)
30 to 30+ students = £130.00 per student.
25 to 30 students = £135.00 per student.
15 to 25 students - £1/10 00 per student

This includes a surcharge of approximately £7.50 per student levied by the DofE Ltd for our provision as an AAP.
