

Up until the school closed, Morristown College was the only East Tennessee junior college to produce a graduate NBA player. After a stellar career at his senior college, he was inducted into the school's and state's Halls of Fame (Wilbur Holland).

Morristown College's faculty and staff were highly trained with most having advanced degrees from major universities. At one point, the College had a higher percentage of its instructors with doctoral degrees than many 4-year institutions.
