A HISTORY OF UNION COUNTY
AND
EL DORADO

Union County was formed November 2, 1829, while Arkansas was yet a territory. It originally embraced the present Bradley, Ouachita, Drew, Ashley and Calhoun counties, and parts of Dallas, Columbia, Nevada, Lincoln, Cleveland (originally Dorsey) and Lafayette counties.

The first county seat was at Ecore Fabre (now Camden), a pioneer crossing place on the Ouachita River, so named for a Frenchman who located there prior to 1806 and was possibly the first permanent settler of the region. It was here the pioneers usually quit their boats and re-outfitted for the farther journey to the West and here, also, returning pilgrims sought boats to carry them downstream. Thus, it became an early settlement of importance. Although no courthouse was erected, this place remained the county seat, with court held at the home of John Nunn, until 1839 when the State began to cut Union to form other counties, and Ecore Fabre came to be situated "in the corner of the County".

In January 1839, Scarborough's Landing on the Ouachita was designated the county seat. This location was given the name Champagnolle and grew to be a flourishing community and the shipping point for a wide territory. The first government land office in this region was established there, but court was held in the back of a store and the arrangement did not last long. In the early 1840s settlements began to develop West of the river, Mount Holly being among the first, and the people of the growing county were again clamoring for a change to a more centrally located seat of justice.

The citizens filed a petition with the county court in July 1843, asking for the removal of the county site from Champagnolle. The County Judge ordered an election to select three commissioners to choose a new location. On October 10, 1843, the commissioners reported to open court that they had selected "that portion of the county lying in the vicinity of the center, upon the South Quarter of Section 28, Township 17 South, Range 15 West, as being the best located place to promote the convenience and interest of the majority of the inhabitants of said county."

It is said that "rulers and a map" decided this new location, a section of partially cleared land which had been settled and pre-empted by the Matthew F. Rainey family in the fall of 1842. Rainey was a former Alabama politician of note who was beset by financial difficulties resulting in the loss of all his holdings in Greene County. He thence loaded up his family and headed West, the story being his wagon broke-down at this new site and he decided to stay. On December 2, 1843, Rainey deeded his pre-emption rights on the quarter section to the commissioners, withholding a four acre tract on which his cabin was located. This historic plot is known today as the "Garrett Lot".

It was in the October 1843 court term the first mention of the name "El Dorado" appears in county records and there is no indication why this name was chosen. It should be noted here that for political reasons some notable citizens were against the move and there resulted quite a controversy over the actual removal of the county records, benches and Judge's seats from Champagnolle. It is believed some early records were lost after being hidden in the woods in a last minute attempt to foil the changeover. They were unsuccessful, however, and El Dorado Township was established in July of 1844, with county court being held there the first time on October 14, 1844.

Even the prestige of being the "county town" failed to induce settlers to locate within its limits. The Town of Hillsboro boasted a larger population and more businesses and El Dorado remained a somewhat rural village of no importance until the coming of the railroad in 1889. Prior to this time, communication with the outer world was held principally by the Ouachita River packets, either through El Dorado Landing (now Calion) or the original landing at Champagnolle.

A Times-Democrat reporter upon visiting El Dorado in 1883 found it to be one of the prettiest and most delightfully situated towns in Arkansas, stating the striking characteristic of the town was its extreme cleanliness and neatness; and of the 500 inhabitants, their healthy appearance and affable manners. He reported that "in the centre of the town is a large substantial courthouse, built of brick in 1848, and surrounded by a large square shaded by beautiful sycamores, catalpas and cedars. The business portion of the town is confined to the streets fronting on the square."

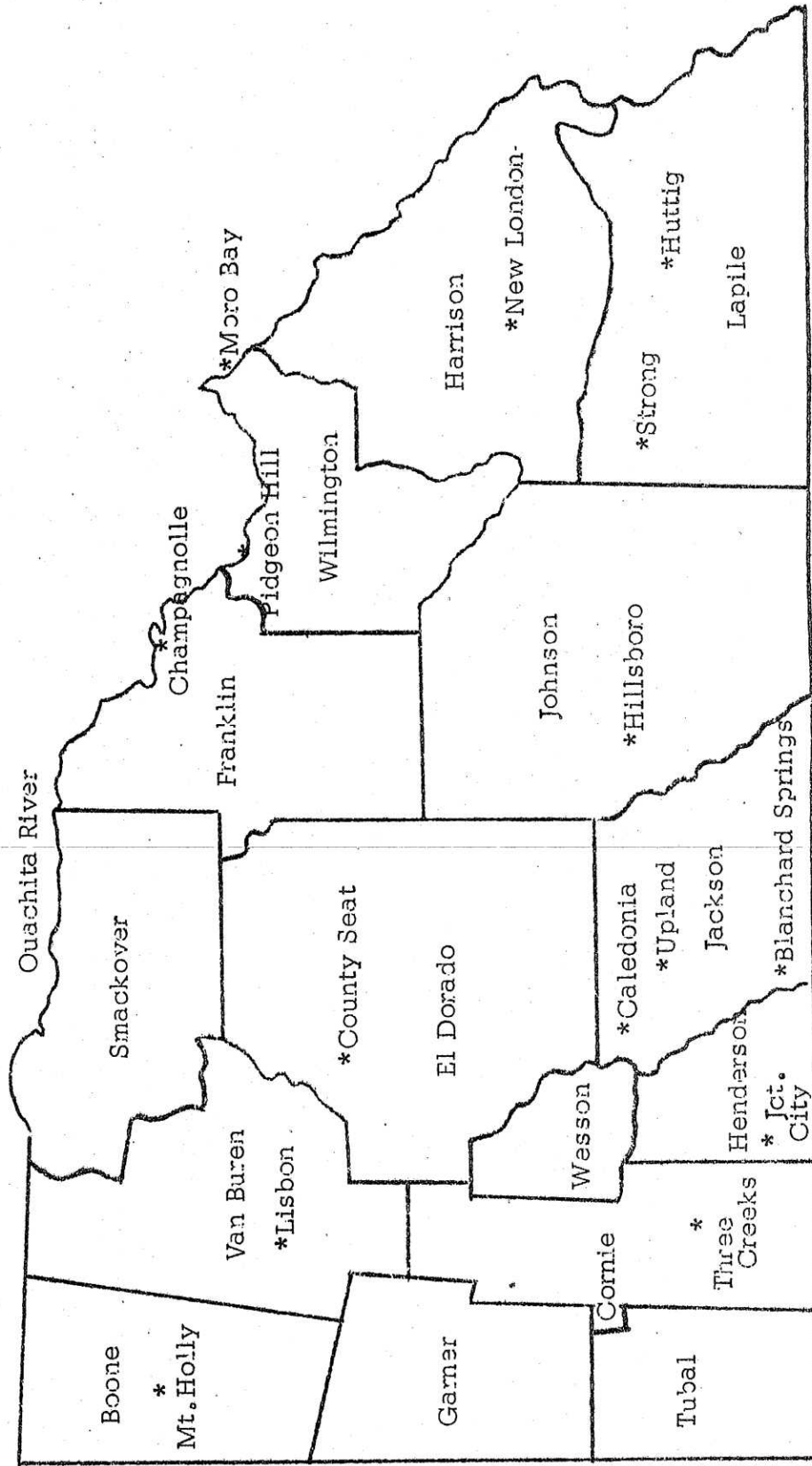
The population of Union County in 1883 was 13,419, of which 6,985 were white and 6,434 were black. The settlers were principally Georgians and Alabamians, with a small sprinkling of Mississippians and Carolinians. Medical statistics showed that Union County was the second healthiest in the Southern states, and El Dorado because of its altitude, was considered the healthiest place in the county.

There remains vast untold history of Union County during its "hey-day" or antebellum years, throughout the Civil War years, reconstruction and the oil boom, which we have not touched upon here. It is our plan to include a "history" section in each subsequent issue of "Tracks & Traces".

GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY LAUNCHES MOVE TO SAVE HISTORIC PROPERTY

Restoration of the RAINEY-NEWTON HOME, one of El Dorado's last remaining antebellum structures, will soon be a reality. The two-story home at 510 North Jackson, is a well preserved example of provincial Arkansas architecture of the mid-nineteenth century. Its simple lines are expressive of the unpretentious lifestyle prevalent in frontier Arkansas. It was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1974, along with the Garrett Home, which has since burned.

The Rainey-Newton Home was constructed by John Newton, a native Georgian, who came to Union County from Autauga County, Alabama, in the year 1842. Newton first settled near Champagnolle and soon amassed a 2,500 acre plantation, which prospered until the turn of the century, and known in later years as the Wright farm. After the establishment of El Dorado as county seat, Newton began buying city property and by 1849 owned 546 acres of the now popular northeast section and had built the family home on the 4-acre "Matthew Rainey Tract" previously mentioned. Many young ladies from outlying areas in the county were afforded board in the home while attending the El Dorado Female Academy (of which Newton was an original founder) during the pre-Civil War era. It was also a haven to circuit preachers and educators in need of lodging during their stays in the City. The original structure had two detached kitchens in the rear, which have since been joined to the main house.

The home remained in the John Newton family until 1898 when it was sold by his daughter and son-in-law, Alabama and John C. Wright, to

Charles Denning. After only a year, Denning sold the house to John Hill, who occupied it until 1909 when it was purchased by Rufus N. Garrett. In 1910 Garrett moved it about 300 yards to the northeast of its original location (on mule-drawn logs) and built the Garrett mansion on the site. Ownership has since remained in the Garrett estate until it was brought to the attention of the Genealogical Society last November it would soon be placed on the open market.

Fearing the property would be sold for business purposes and the home destroyed, our president, Edward Baker, negotiated a six-month Option to Purchase in the name of the society. A steering committee comprised of a small group from the society then began investigating "ways and means" to effect the purchase and subsequent restoration. The matter was brought to the public's attention through appearances before the City Council and a local garden club. No funds were forthcoming, however, from the city, but it was ascertained the general public had an enormous interest in saving the property.

By February the steering committee had expanded to include those persons in the community keenly interested in working toward the project and "Rainey-Newton Restoration Committee" was organized, with Mrs. Robert W. Ragsdale and Mrs. W. Joe Wilson agreeing to co-chair. While it was apparent federal funding was available on a 50-50 matching fund basis, such an application was not feasible due to the limited time prior to expiration of the Option. Neither was there time to file certain papers with the Federal and State Governments, necessary to qualify the society for fund raising on a tax exempt basis. It was then brought to the attention of the Committee that a group of influential business men of the area had incorporated under the name SOUTH ARKANSAS HISTORICAL FOUNDATION, INC. some years ago for the purpose of creating an Oil Museum in Union County. While no action had been taken by the group to date, it remained a corporation with the necessary qualifications to solicit funding for such a project as the Rainey-Newton restoration. A joint meeting was called between the board members of that group and the "restoration committee", wherein it was agreed the two would merge and consolidate their efforts.

The Historical Foundation has 38 active members to date. At the last meeting on September 22nd it was announced by finance chairman, Perrin Jones, that the necessary papers to finalize the purchase are now in the process of being drawn and funds have been contributed from anonymous donors to cover the purchase price.

The goal of the foundation is to make the necessary structural repairs to put the house in sound condition, replace the roofing, paint outside and cleanup the grounds this year. In 1978 a public fund raising campaign will be launched to effect the restoration and maintenance.

In not too many years, the Rainey-Newton Home will doubtless be a showplace for South Arkansas. The Union County Genealogical Society can be proud of their initial effort and continuing support of this project.

Editor's Note: We advised her that no births were recorded prior to 1917 and those after that date can be obtained through the Bureau of Vital Statistics at Little Rock, Ark..... for proof of these births she should write the Bureau of Personal Census, Walnut Building, Pittsburg, Kansas, for a search of the 1900 Census.
