

Reopen Date Postponed





Our plan for a September 1st opening date has been postponed. We will remain closed to public entry for the time being. We had a delay in our construction schedule and with the uprise of COVID19 cases in our area, we remain cautious and will continue to follow the advice of our medical colleagues.

Medicare Open Enrollment will not be held in person this year, appointments will be required and take place over the phone, via email, teleconference or by mail as we did last year.

We were fortunate to receive a forgiveness loan from the SBA early summer along with a tax credit from the IRS. Those dollars have allowed us to put in new deck ramps with an hands free door at the front entrance and will get our building up to ADA standards. Our repaired parking lot should be completed by month end along with the addition of a garage. There will be a Open House for the public sometime next Spring or early Summer.

FALL TIME SAFETY TIPS

GET YOUR VACCINES! Seniors are at the highest risk for serious

complications from the Flu & COVID19, which can result in hospitalization and even death. Vaccinations are proven to lessen the severity of diseases. Consult with your doctor and make sure you are up to date on recommended shots.

CHECK SMOKE DETECTORS & REPLACE BATTERIES—Fall is the perfect time to check and replace batteries in your smoke & carbon monoxide detectors. Replace any light bulbs and keep your house properly lighted to prevent possible falls.

WEAR GOOD SHOES—Use waterproof, non-slip shoes, Autumn is notorious for slippery leaves and icy rain.

MAINTAIN YOUR VEHICLE—Get your car into the shop for a regular tune-up. Having a vehicle in proper working condition makes it less likely for you to get into an accident or breakdown in dangerous weather conditions. Make sure tires are in good shape and all headlights, taillights, and signals are working properly.

DON'T LEAVE CANDLES UNATTENDED —During Autumn, there is a noticeable uptick in fires caused by improper candle use. Never leave a candle burning if you leave the house or may fall asleep. Be sure to keep candles away from high traffic areas, pets, & anything flammable.


