#### **IMPROVE HOME SAFETY WITH THESE TIPS**

Small rugs pose a danger. If you don't want to remove them, add some rubber grips.

Make sure all stairs, hallways, and other passage area are free from obstruction.

Whenever possible, eliminate steps or replace them

In the bathroom, consider changing walk-in showers to a zero clearance shower-one with no threshold to

Stairways can be safer by the adding handrails on both sides. Handrails on the porch or inside the garage can make access easier.

Doorway thresholds can be removed to allow for easier movement with a walker, some may need to be widened.

Improve your lighting. Inside and outside. Sometimes this can happen just by using higher wattage bulbs. Bending. Sitting, and standing can be challenging for seniors, depending on individual difficulties. Raised toilets, lower counters and shallow sinks can help make daily life easier.

Round knobs on faucets and doors can be replaced with lever handles making them easier to turn them on and off.

#### If you don't have internet access, don't worry, there are still a lot of activities to busy yourself with.


Work on a puzzle!
