## **INTRODUCTION**

From September 2021 to February 2022, the last phase of the AppForDem project "Educational app for caregivers of people with dementia" is being carried out in Denmark, Romania, Italy, and Spain. The partners are organizing validation activities through groups of experts, pilot workshops with the target groups, and dissemination seminars aimed at educational decision makers, teachers, students, formal, non-formal caregivers and professionals in the long-term care sector. # 3<sup>RD</sup> TRANSNATIONAL MEETING IN BOLOGNA

The Third transnational meeting was held at the headquarters of Anziani e Non Solo in the city of Bologna (Italy) on October 11, 2021. The partners discussed the current situation and defined the strategy for the last stage of the project. The key issues of the meeting focused on organizing a pilot process with the target groups.

The partners exchanged views on the methodology and deadlines for holding two workshops in Spain, Romania, and Italy to test the app and the e-learning course. The partners agreed on February 10 and 11 for the final meeting in Spain.








## **GROUPS OF EXPERTS**

To validate learning content and materials



In the second phase of the project, each partner organized a group of experts to validate the content and learning materials produced at this stage.


In total 28 experts on the field of dementia from the different partner countries provided their opinions and suggestions on the proposed content. Specific validation results regarding the feedback from all participants involved and the specific resources are presented below.

A final comparative report was drafted with the following elements: a didactic guide, an e-learning course, and a educational app.

### **DIDACTIC GUIDE**

The didactic guide is considered a very useful document by the experts, showing in a simple way the learning resources and content of the educational app and the elearning course and facilitating their use. The experts highlighted the following:

- ✓ The language is simple, clear and suitable for the target groups;
- ✓ The organisation of topics is smooth and linear throughout the document;
- ✓ Tables and illustrations facilitate orientation with regard to both content and access to resources.

## **EDUCATIONAL APP**

# The "Dementia and daily living" app was highly appreciated by experts and was considered a very innovative and above all useful resource for both formal and informal caregivers. In particular, it was appreciated for its usefulness, ease of use and very sensitive and reassuring language. The use of graphic summaries was also considered very important


both in terms of learning and to break up the


seriousness of the topics covered.

## **E-LEARNING COURSE**

Experts considered the <u>e-learning course</u> a very attractive user interface, also due to the comic and the short summaries. In the same way, the comics used in the cases were considered very useful to encourage self-learning through the use of these resources.

In addition, the experts rated positively that the management of the course is intuitive and facilitates its use for people with low digital competence.







## PILOTING PROCESS. WORKSHOPS WITH TARGET GROUPS

In the last stage of the AppForDem project, partners carried out a piloting process aimed at testing the educational app "dementia and daily living" and the e-learning course "specialized care for caregivers of people with dementia" with the project target groups in Romania, Italy and Spain.

From October to December 2021, ANS, HABILITAS and MENSAJEROS organized two workshops in their countries aimed at evaluating the usability of the aforementioned learning resources. A total **of 37 organizations and 84 participants** (20 in Spain, 17 in Italy and 44 in Romania) were involved in the process.



In general, **the opinions of the participants show a high degree** of satisfaction with the 9 items defined in the guidelines document for the piloting
