

# FERAL CAT SPAY/NEUTER CLINIC

The number of feral cats in the U.S. is estimated to be in the tens of millions. CAC is dedicated to providing extreme low-cost spay/neuter services to feral cats in our community and the surrounding areas.

- Feral cat spay/neuter is by appointment only. Call 208.772.4019 to schedule an appointment.
- Feral cat spay/neuter is \$30.
- Spay/neuter cost includes a Rabies vaccination.
- All cats altered under this program will have their ear tipped. <u>THIS IS NOT OPTIONAL.</u> (Ear-tip is a universal indicator that a cat has been altered.)
- Only ONE cat per trap. All cats must be in a trap or hard plastic carrier that is safe and secure.
- Cats in cardboard boxes/carriers WILL NOT be accepted!
- Check-in time is 9 9:30 AM. Allow 30 minutes for check-in. Payment is made at check-in.
- Pick-up time is 5 5:30 PM the same day of surgery.
- Rescue groups can reserve up to four spots.
- Individuals can reserve up to two spots.

#### ALL FERALS MUST BE PICKED UP BY END OF DAY!

#### **Live Animal Trap Rental**

CAC has traps available for rental for those individuals who need to trap ferals to bring them in for spay/neuter.

- Call 208.772.4019 to reserve a trap.
- Rental cost is \$50, refundable deposit.
- Traps are available for a 10-day rental period.
- If trap is returned damaged, dirty, or not in working condition, your deposit <u>WILL NOT</u> be refunded.

### **BENEFITS OF SPAY/NEUTER**

The health benefits of spaying and neutering are numerous. Altered pets have a much lower risk of reproductive cancers and generally live longer lives. Females will not go in heat (eliminating the messiness and anxious behavior associated with a cycle) or experience any complications during birth. Spayed females have less risk of mammary and ovarian cancer, and no risk of life-threatening uterine infections (Pyrometra). Males are less likely to engage in undesirable behaviors such as urine marking, humping, aggression, and roaming to seek out a mate. It also eliminates the possibility of testicular cancer.

## **SPAY AND NEUTER CLINIC**

**CAC's spay/neuter clinic is open to everyone!** We do our best to keep our prices low so people can afford this important surgery. Our actual cost to perform the surgery is much higher than what we charge.

#### • Surgery is by appointment only.

- The spay/neuter clinic is for cats and dogs ONLY.
- All cats and dogs must be a minimum of 16 weeks of age.
- All cats and dogs must be healthy, not on medication, and have no prior medical disorders. (CAC reserves the right to decline any cat or dog for surgery based on medical or behavioral findings.)
- Spay services are not offered for female dogs 7 years and older and female cats 10 years and older.
- This is same day surgery.
- Vaccinations and microchipping is also available at the time of surgery.

#### **Important Information!**

- When you arrive for your appointment drop off, text
  208.510.0496. Wait in your vehicle with your pet until you are contacted. Allow up to 60 minutes for patient check-in from the time you text in.
- Drop Off Time: Between 8 9 AM.
- Dogs under 25 lbs must be in a clean, secure pet carrier. Dogs 26 lbs and up must be on leash.
- Cats must be in a clean, secure pet carrier with a towel or

# blanket. Cardboard carriers/boxes will not be accepted!

**Pickup -** *Do not text upon arrival. Come into the lobby.* 

- Dogs are released starting after 2 PM by text or call ONLY.
- Cats are released between 5-5:30 PM.

#### **Appointment Reschedule Policy - Spay/Neuter**

Can't make your appointment? Call CAC by noon on the Saturday prior to your appointment. First reschedule is free; second reschedule costs \$20. If second reschedule is missed/ canceled, you will lose your fees previously paid and will need to start with a new appointment.

# **VACCINATION AND MICROCHIP CLINIC**

**CAC's vaccination and microchipping clinic is open to everyone!** We do our best to keep our prices low so people can afford this important service. Vaccinating your cat or dog is easy, inexpensive, and can save your pet's life!

- Vaccines and microchipping are by appointment only.
- The vaccination clinic is for healthy cats and dogs ONLY.
   Pets with a prior vaccination reaction history, sick, or injured, must see a full-service veterinary clinic.
- For the safety of your pet, all dogs must be on leash, and all cats in secure carriers.



 A 3-year Rabies certificate will not be issued without proof of current Rabies.
